Research and Development in The Warrior Class

Before a new concept or design is presented to the public, there is a process of research and development, commonly referred to as "R&D". This is a valuable and strategic time of conversations, questions, experiments and observation. It is filled with processing questions:

- > What is our primary objective?
- > What do we want to accomplish with it?
- ➢ How do we think this might work?
- How can we practice with it and with whom?
- > What did we learn from our practice?
- > What refinements, adaptations and upgrades are needed?

In The Warrior Class, we talk a great deal about being pioneers and explorers. R&D is another way of expressing this concept and one that we've learned to make good use of.

Strategic development requires both vision and intentionality. I loved the example of Jesus that Graham used in his recent article on *The Army and Family of The Warrior Class* in our last Training Journal. Jesus didn't enter the ministry phase of His life at the age of 12, but he was already preparing for it. He had a great deal to learn and important choices to make so that He would be ready to step into the fullness of the Father's destiny for Him when it was time to do so. It was an intentional process of maturity.

The path of development in TWC is very similar. When the Holy Spirit begins stir up a new idea, new territory or future possibility, we enter into a wonderful time of partnering with Him and with various small groups in The Warrior Class to learn, grow and develop towards our next level of divine destiny.

In doing so, we're always looking for these foundational qualities:

- Does it give us a greater understanding and encounter with Christ?
- Does it represent His true nature with excellence?
- Is it faithful to the Values and Principles He's given us in TWC?

Upgrades in The Warrior Class are generally a one to two year process from inspired idea to full scale launch. You will often hear of ideas that are still in the R&D stage in The Warrior Class because we've *always* got something cooking on the stove that's not quite ready for the dinner table yet. Half-baked ideas are not usually very tasty!

A great example is our current upgrade in Intercession with Key Territories. As I've mentioned before, it was over a year ago in one of my conversations with Graham, that we wondered about the sameness in our intel submissions. It was the classic, "What does this mean? What must we do?" moment. What followed were several months of conversations between myself and Christine Casten (Director of Intel), some of our key intel specialists and group activations at two TWC Training Days in Portland and Anaheim to gather some of your ideas. We took time for *lots* of prayer, worship, rejoicing and listening to what God was doing and how we could partner with Him in it.

Once we had God's "compass and a kiss" (sense of direction and permission granted), we took the strategy out for a spin with a small group of members who had been through Intel Development and who seemed a good fit for the R&D phase of this upgrade. We learned a great deal through their insight and feedback so that when it was time to present this to all of TWC, we had some experience to go with it. It's always better to learn your initial lessons on a small scale rather than a large one.

Our TWC Intercession upgrade into Key Territories is our primary focus right now because that's the stage of development it is in.

While Intercession is currently on the front burner, we're cooking up some future upgrades to The Warrior Class that are in the R&D stage. We've got a great team of TWCers who have just finished the New Member Process and have volunteered to explore some new team concepts and resources with me. Because they are newer members, these young Warrior Team pioneers have never had a different TWC experience, so there's nothing to unlearn! They can give us feedback that we'll all benefit from in the future as we position ourselves to step into our next level of our corporate promises and prophecies.

And, if you want more detail than that... then watch this space in the next 4 to 12 months! In the meantime, enjoy establishing our Key Territories personally and corporately.

Delight in our present, knowing that we're planning and working towards our future.

Together, we're all Kingdom explorers, pioneers, map makers... and Research and Development specialists!

We want to see a community of believers raised up in this country and around the world who are absolutely provoked by the majesty, the sovereignty, the sovereignty, the beauty and the magnificence of who God is. 




No fee is required but a donation towards the meeting room expense is appreciated

My Identity Statement:


I am a skilled listener operating in humility and gentleness, asking powerful questions that create a safe place for resolving conflict and bringing awareness of possibilities.
