Our Upgrades to TWC Training for 2017

Welcome to New Territory Warrior Class – this is going to be a fabulous year of upgrades, discovery and putting stakes in the ground. One of our upgraded areas is in our training. You have had some great questions on what our training will look like and here is a brief overview.

As you look for those places of where you want to plant your stake in the ground, know that your training will be key in helping you drive that stake deep.

We've refined our training to focus on developing spiritual Warriors, Prophetic Intercession and crafting New Testament focused prophetic words as part of the prayer and declaration process. All of our Training Levels and Advanced Training Modules will have that focus.

While our Level 1 Training on *Qualities of a Spiritual Warrior* and our true identity remains largely the same, here are the upgrades in our training that we are entering 2017 with:

Level 2 Training has now become three modules. Each are submitted after they are completed to divide the topic into smaller units and offer you more frequent feedback. You can do these in any order and if you've already completed Level 2, you can choose to do just one of the newer Modules 2 & 3 so that you don't miss that training.

Level 2 – The Heart of Prophecy

- Module 1: Approaching the Heart of Prophecy
- Module 2: Making a Prophetic Impact
- Module 3: Introduction to Prophetic Intercession and Intel

After Levels 1 and 2 are completed, there will be no more “levels,” but **Advanced Training Modules**. From here forward in TWC, you can choose any of these in any order that you wish. These are the Advanced Training Modules we are starting with, but more will be added throughout the year:

1. Overcoming Life 1: Setting the Scene for Battle
2. Manifesting Your Spirit
3. Coming Into Alignment
4. Fighting with Fruit

IMPORTANT: **ALL** previous TWC Training Levels will be accepted throughout 2017. There is still great value in all of our previous Training Levels. When you finish your current Training Level, submit it for feedback and then choose one of the *new* training options.

As you start this journey into new territory, take time to observe, get to know your traveling companions, then have fun exploring!

We are coming up higher, and coming up deeper!
