**Church of the Hills** is one of those places where it is most enjoyable to speak. It has been a place of building for me for the past six years. Currently the church is in a time of leadership change with the previous pastor becoming the founding pastor and a new senior pastor having been appointed a year ago. It is a father-to-son transition with Charles giving way to Chad. Both men are hugely enjoyable to talk to and time spent with them is lively and interesting.

I took three meetings over the weekend and also spent time with the leaders and leadership team. In the first meeting I spoke on **“Understanding Your Spiritual Lens.”**

This is a message designed to open up the way that we see in the Spirit and release people to examine their assumptions, traditions and experiences of God in the light of Scripture. If we cannot see properly our mindset becomes distorted and therefore in our language we cannot communicate with God at the appropriate level of fullness, nor can we express this nature in a way that is glorious and profound. A religious system provides a lens that distorts the light and cannot reveal God in all His majesty. Church of the Hills has experienced a fresh influx of people from a variety of church backgrounds and it is vital that people have the eyes of their heart enlightened.

My second message was **“Reinventing Your Walk in the Fruit of the Spirit.”** This is concerned with cultivating a powerful, influential lifestyle using the nature of God in all our relationships as defined by the Fruit of the Spirit.

**The best place to develop ourselves in the image of God is to forcefully bring the Fruit of the Spirit to bear on all our relationships.**

All of our circumstances will change dramatically as we learn to move specifically in God's nature. People need to learn how to step back from negative mindsets and emotions and be trained to use situations more productively in the pursuit of God's presence.

My third message was called **“Fullness Now!”** It is concerned with how God stands in the gap between our potential and our actual development in Christ and resources the whole journey. We have been made complete in Christ and have been blessed with all spiritual blessings in Christ.

We therefore have this assurance that as we are growing up into Christ in all things, then every part of our life is covered by the favor of God to resource us as we develop in relationship with Him. God has granted to us everything that pertains to life and godliness. In that context of completion He has granted us incredible, precious and magnificent promises so that we may become partakers of His divine nature.

All messages were very well received. As I was speaking there was a quietness, a stillness, almost an unresponsiveness in the auditorium. It was because people were hearing something for them that was totally new and it was messing with their lens. Each time there was a powerful response to the appeal.

Off to Ohio next. Thanks y'all for being in the fight.

### **Family Christian Center**

Defiance, Ohio  
August 8-10, 2013

A hard place to get to, a good place for a fight. Three planes, all delayed, meant I got into my bed at 2:30am with a 7am breakfast meeting on the agenda, and my suitcase lost in space for a further thirty-six hours...seriously? That's not warfare, just spitefulness. Anyhow, a good moment to allocate patience and laughter to a situation I've experienced many times in the last four decades.

The event was exactly what it said in the title: **Breakthrough!** My plan was to leave with the people, and the region, a bunch of keys on a key ring: revelation, favor and authority that would bind and loose, lock up and unlock situations; mindsets and perspectives that would empower people to live in an enlightened way in the Spirit of Jesus.

I spoke on "**Understanding Your Spiritual Lens,**" that opens up people's eyes to see who they are in Christ and gives them power over religious assumptions and poor Christian doctrine. Religion captures people and enslaves them to an anti-truth rationale. Jesus captivates people to a spirit of personal freedom.

"**Waking up the New Man**" was an off-the-cuff talk given in the spirit of the moment, which combined Romans 6 with Eph 4 and outlined the real value of the Cross of Christ. I wanted to bloody the nose of religious behavior modification and empower people to see the futility of trying to change their old self.

The place was as quiet as a ghost town during a national holiday. Putting my foot on the neck of that thing is deeply satisfying. One could sense people waking up. The whole event was an "eye-opener" for numerous delegates.

**Worship was short but powerful. The group was excellent in getting people on their feet. Good music, great voices, powerful energy. The delegates were enthusiastic, attentive and very responsible.**

The third message was "**Reframing and the Mind of Christ**", focusing particularly on how to do spiritual appraisals (1 Cor. chapter 2) of life and circumstances. It is so critical for people to get wisdom in its proper place as the art of thinking with the spirit, not the natural mind. I enjoy logic, reason and my intellect but I absolutely adore wisdom as the true place of thinking in Christ.

I spoke on "**The Fruit of the Spirit**" as a prime way of becoming Christ-like in our emotions. Most of our main areas of test are going to be in relationships and also in life situations that may call up negative emotions as part of our reaction/response. God has placed a fruit of the Spirit in every negative situation we face so that we may develop restraint (self control) over our negativity and move into an encounter with His nature instead. In that learning context He has given us permission to allocate a specific fruit of the Spirit to any particular situation or relationship. This is a massive key that opens us up to being made in God's image and also prevents relationships from becoming negative and destructive.

My final talk was on **“The Law of the Spirit of Life in Christ.”** This is a good message to end an event with because it provides people with a radical perspective on the nature and the power of the Kingdom. It creates a place where people can be freed from earth-bound thinking to cultivate mindsets that are in line with being a joint heir with Christ and a citizen of Heaven. There are so many skeleton keys (a lock-picking bounty) in this talk that encourages people to truly understand the emphasis of kingdom over world perspectives.

**The favor available to us in the Kingdom is huge and full of majesty. We have, in Christ, found favor in God’s eyes!**

More spitefulness on the journey home. Delayed flights meant I had to stay overnight before completing my journey the next day. At least my bag was waiting for me in Santa Barbara.

A few weeks of resting, some writing, time with family from the UK and a certain 60<sup>th</sup> birthday (where did all the time go?) before I head to Portland at the end of August for the School of Prophecy.

## Taking our training into our communities!

### Allison Bown

During the Portland Sessions, Lecia Retter and I had a wonderful conversation about the follow up she's done with many of the students at George Fox University since Graham's visit there in January of this year. I got to chat with a few of them and they were delightful! We rarely get to see what happens after Graham's assignments, so I asked her to share her experiences with TWC. Seeing breakthroughs followed through is our passion and Lecia is using her TWC training to invest in that dream.

### Lecia Retter

In May 2011, I began working at George Fox University as an Enrollment Manager. On my very first break, I walked the canyon loop, a circular route that weaves past most dorms, the library, and the cafeteria. On this route I realized that although my *job* is in the Registrar's Office, my *purpose* is intercession. My heart cried out for students to encounter God in a fresh way, and break free from the religious spirit. Twice a day I walked the canyon loop, and prayed for a door to open for Graham to speak at chapel. I also longed for an opportunity to meet with students. Both prayers were answered earlier this year. Graham's chapel talks opened up pathways to brilliant thinking, and students were invited to meet me that evening if they wanted to learn more.

Eight students walked into the Prayer Chapel that night. I didn't have a set plan, but Holy Spirit did. As we discussed Graham's talks, themes began to emerge. The "**Give me my stuff back**" story jump-started a conversation about what it means to live a life of "instead." One thought ignited another, and soon we had a few themes: living a life of "instead", discovering who God is for us in this season, God only works on our righteousness, and freedom in the Spirit.

### **By the end of the evening we all agreed that we would like to dive into Papa's heart together.**

Momentum in the Spirit carries us along. The only expectation in our group, "Intentional Intimacy," is that we will encounter God. Our time together typically begins with the question, "Where did you see God this week?" and conversation flows from there. As I weave in concepts I learn from The Warrior Class, students have begun to search out Graham's teachings on the internet, and share materials they've purchased at conferences. Expansive thinking is contagious, we infect one another, and more students come.

A favorite memory of several students was our communion service at the beginning of Lent. We each shared a negative thing in our life, declared the opposite, and then decided together that since the negative is dead anyway we would give it up for Lent. We joyfully celebrated communion together over our "insteads" and rejoiced in our growth the next few weeks.

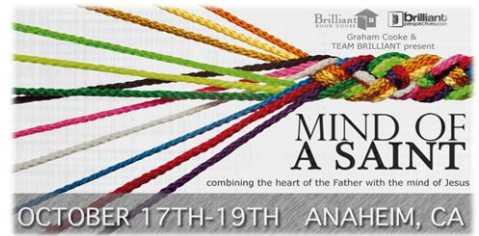
### **I asked a couple of students how "Intentional Intimacy" has impacted their lives:**

*"The group has taught me that I can receive God's love and the love of others just as I am. I need this love to be changed into Christ's image."*

*"Our group has affected me toward a habit/attitude of expectation for the work God is doing in us and through us. My understanding/application of moving in the opposite spirit has deepened through our exploration of God's Kingdom, and His heart."*

As we start another term together, I know these things will continue to be true: people will be healed, we will love each other deeply, share what we're learning from Graham's teaching, practice brilliant thinking together, worship over the campus, and declare truth into the atmosphere. Some students will stay. Some will go. All will encounter Jesus.
