Arise! Women's Conference

Sacramento, CA March 21-22 Frontline News

Arise! Women is an embryonic movement that came out Lutheran renewal into the mainstream church in recent years. Led by the effervescent Denise Siemens and an energetic ministry team, they are passionate about stretching the boundaries of freedom in Christ and being unbounded in the Holy Spirit.

This conference, titled: "His Joy, My Strength," is one of a series of events that I have spoken at in partnership with Denise and Co. I spoke on the subjects of: Freedom in Christ; Newness of Life; Fruit of the Spirit; Renewing your Spiritual Lens.




We had the same responses we always get from mainstream church people gathered for an event outside their normal constituency. "I've been in church for 37 (21, 26, 29, 34, etc.) years and I have never heard this truth spoken. Using careful biblical exegesis allied with testimony and personal experience we diligently plotted the course of what life in Jesus actually roles like to the father.

It is a battle for people to let go of any bondage but especially the religious kind that is semirooted in scripture. People have received consistent input that has made God seem capricious, unapproachable and hard to please. Guilt, shame, fear and condemnation are the normal Christian experience. People have been conditioned into sin consciousness, sin management and behavioral modification instead of freedom from sin, God consciousness and living in their identity in Christ. Truth has been twisted into bondage. Grace has been maligned by a performance mentality trying to earn blessing. Fear of sin has replaced God's goodness and kindness.

Battling these abnormal spiritual experiences is a large part of the focus for Brilliant Perspectives. In particular, setting people free to be amazed at Jesus; filled with wonder about the Father; and astonished at the power and wisdom of the helper, the brilliant Holy Spirit.







It really is a Galatians 3:1-3 encounter. It is foolish to believe we are one perfected in a manner different than God has decreed. There is something so sad about believing that salvation is a gift but that sanctification is earned by performance. "Who has bewitched you?" i.e. who lied to you? Who tricked you into believing this religious nonsense?

This is strong language from Paul who was constantly battling false teaching throughout his entire ministry.

Through the medium of book publishing, magazines, radio, T.V. and now Internet, false teaching is a more virulent problem than Paul ever faced. The fight is ongoing and ruthless. It is a billion dollar industry that will defend its territory using lies, deceit and misrepresentation of the truth. The battle must be fought with grace, truth, and the nature of God. It must be conducted in humility, integrity and joy. It's hard for Pharisees to look outside the twisted theology of their own invention and prejudice. We must pray that enough Bereans will search the scriptures to see if these things are true. Acts 17:10-12.

If our teaching does not set people free to encounter God and develop experience of the Christ life for themselves then we must ask the question: "What has replaced freedom as our truth objective?"

This is a great fight to be involved in with the Holy Spirit. As ever it's always nice to have TWC in the event praying. Allison came for a day. I am enjoying not being alone in this battle.

It is for freedom that Christ has set us free.

Aglow is currently on a journey of reinvention and development for their destiny in the 21st century. Graham continues to partner with Jane Hansen-Hoyt and the core leadership of Aglow to gauge their progress, scout for those who can pioneer this process and create a path of equipping and development towards the massive Kingdom assignment Aglow carries.

Last June, a group of leaders gathered in this same location to be trained in the GameChanger teachings. The purpose was to scout and develop those with a passion to grasp and lead this process of redefinition for Aglow. They were given assignments to work on during the next six months, a new experience for most.

I felt that I saw some significant upgrades this time, as many more seemed to arrive with the understanding that these sessions were a beginning for the next level, not an event that ended on Saturday. There were excellent tools put into their hands during the event and opportunities to activate their learning, as in the "Stuff I'm Giving Back" list. The focus in these meetings was the LifeChanger process that we desire to see all Aglow members encounter: a process of development that focused on the New Man where people are meant to encounter transformation through both knowledge and experience.

Graham took the subject of New Man and delivered 5 targeted laser shots of truth, each with five to six "Keys". Here is a sampling:

The Newness of Life in Christ: Key: The language of God gives us confidence and certainty. Key: God gives you permission to step into His thinking about you, so that in that place He can create a lifestyle of who you are becoming (Rom. 6:11) Key: Your real power is created from your awareness of God. Key: Identify your lifestyle through the language that God is using to describe how He sees you. On Grace: Key: Grace is not undeserved favor. It is the empowering presence of God that enables you to become the person God sees every time He looks at you. Key: When the enemy is radically opposing us, grace only needs to be sufficient to overwhelm him. Key: Grace is the catalyst for our boldness and confidence in our relationship with God. Key: Grace must dominate everything. Key: When you give place to a negative, you frustrate the grace of God. In Building a Spiritual Mindset:

Key: We are practicing relational thinking. Our mindset in the Spirit must be built on the presence of God in us and the purpose of God for us.
Key: The adoption as sons takes places in our circumstances.
Key: God is training us for sonship – relentlessly.
Key: Building the right mindset is the key to healthy emotions.

On the Practical Applications of the New Man:

Key: God gives you a new vocabulary to explore life as a New Man.

Key: God is preoccupied with the New You.

Key: You can't mix the Old Man with the New Man.

Key: God is not dealing with our behavior but our identity in Christ.

The natural mind can't cope with the lifestyle of Christ.

Aglow is an on-going assignment for TWC, led by the Warrior Eagles team but one that we can all pray regularly for. Graham has sown into this community for over eight years and will be speaking at both the U.S. and Canadian national conferences later this year. It's an opportunity to explore how to upgrade a culture into the next level of their destiny on a global scale. It's a big assignment and an even greater opportunity for us all.

Level 1 Training Call

Level 1 Training Call by Teresa Morrison

We had our first Level 1 Training Call for 2014.

There were 19 people on the call! We answered questions that members sent in ahead of time, here are some of the questions:

- How do I gain confidence in my training process?
- Which Training Journals should I focus on for Level 1?
- · How creative can we be with Crafted Prayers?
- Discussing the process of assembling your Level 1 to send in. What are we looking for? How does that work?

We had an open dialog about confidence which is one topic that seems to come up a lot. One way that confidence is built is through discovering who you are IN HIM. Personally, I started my Level 1 Training with my ID Statement, it changes and gets upgraded as I see myself as God sees me. It is the perfect love of God that casts out all fear, and brings me to a place of security and confidence IN HIM.

Another question was about which Training Journals go with Level 1 Training. We have posted Training Journal #3 - Kingdom Identity and #7 - Powerful Questions on our website as resources. These are only a starting point, there are 11 other Training Journals to look over. A whole library. If you find a wellspring that assisted you during your training, feel free to mention it on our FB page.

Crafted Prayer, how creative can we be? I love to chat about this topic! Many of you have recently gone through the application process there were some pointers on crafting a prayer:

Each line should be a lightning strike with purpose for a specific target.

Write as if you were paying for every word of a telegram. *Make every word count.*

Your prayer should be from 6-10 lines. "Long enough to be powerful, short enough to memorize." ~ Graham

Allison gave a great illustration of this; we have all heard Graham say that "Rest is a Weapon." This came from Graham journaling three pages on rest, reducing it to one and cutting it to one sentence, then narrowing it down to a one-liner. It packs a huge punch, and carries weight in the Spirit! A really good illustration!

Lastly, we discussed the process of assembling your Level 1 Training. The idea is to keep a word document on your computer saving your process and backing it up. As far as the process goes you decide where you start. Level 1 was not written as a step by step process. You can start wherever you would like. I started with #3 my ID Statement. You have the freedom to begin wherever the Holy Spirit highlights. This training is for you!

Thank you for all of your comments on our FB Page following the call. We're glad that it answered some of your key questions. Stay tuned for more training calls in the near future. I enjoyed hearing and recognizing your voices from the interview process, no doubt you all have hit the ground running, I admire your excellence upon arrival!
