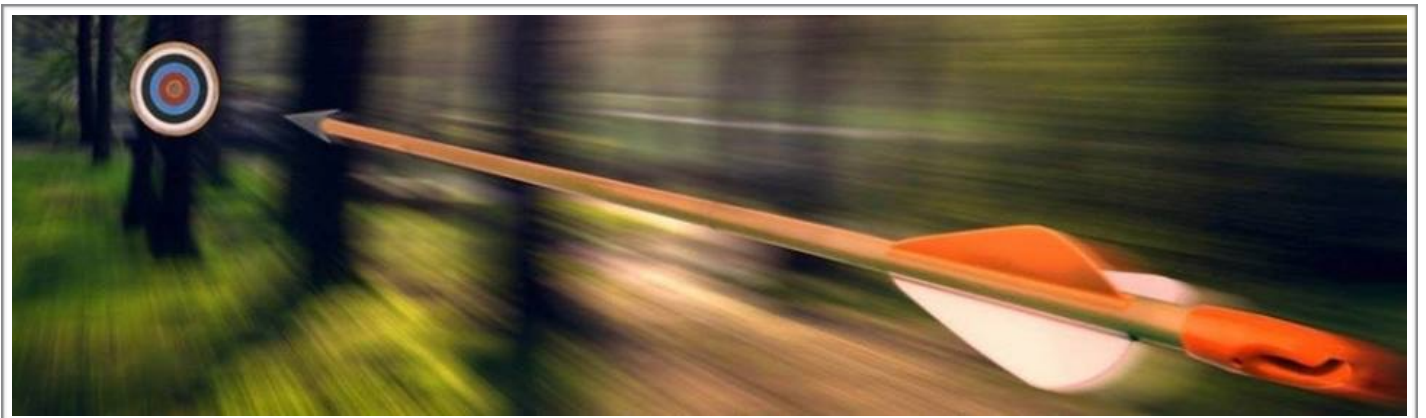

Welcome to TWC!

If you're just joining us, congratulations! Your adventure in TWC now begins through the Foundations Training. You'll get to know some of our veteran members and coaches, as you explore the resources that The Warrior Class has to offer.

This Guidebook is a tool to help you navigate the many aspects of The Warrior Class. We update it several times a year and post it on the website so you can print a new copy. Because we are a process (not a program), we provide you with tools and invitational opportunities.

The rest is up to you and how much you wish to pursue. Everyone has a unique pace of growth, diverse interests and varying levels of priority.

We firmly believe that it is the process with God, and journey together, that makes us rich. So, enjoy your explorations. Allow Holy Spirit to help you sort and prioritize how He desires for The Warrior Class to work for you. No one else's journey will be quite like yours.

An Overview of The Warrior Class

The Warrior Class provides a place for those who are hungry for deeper relationship with God and a tribe of Kingdom-minded warriors. We seek to strengthen identity in Christ as we explore more of the life of a New Testament spiritual warrior and what's possible in prophetic intercession.

We have specific assignments in the Kingdom (see Kingdom Assignments on the website) that we know are ours to pursue and expand. We are inclusive in our thinking, but also realize the passion to train at the highest level is not for everyone.

We also know training at the highest level is not about performing or achieving. It's about deep confidence in relationship with God and each other, along with a solid understanding of who we are and the destiny we are here to fulfill in Jesus. We want these to be your passions as much as they are ours. In our view, what you invest in us is also investing in your development and destiny.

We're warriors, champions, game changers and influencers who take full advantage of our own unique resources. God knows if, someday, you may help us design a unique resource, too!

Our passion is to offer and create plenty of ways for you to train in multiple facets of who you are. Through our training, our main focus is Unity with God's heart and each other. In the process, we develop skills of managing capacity/rhythm with God, leadership, writing, and expression in many different formats. We also encourage passion, tenacity, grit, determination and fortitude along with the fruit of the Spirit.

The Warrior Class is a grand place of dialogue, training, friendship and a good fight to produce Christian warriors and intercessors who are joyful, resilient, powerful and know who they are in Christ.

Our Intercession (Intel) continues to develop and is one area we feel the Lord will allow us to have a Kingdom impact for Him. You get the invitation to be part of that impact each time you step into an invitation to our Intel Process.

The responsibility for your development is **in your hands**. Our part is to supply the resources and opportunities—and we have many available—a buffet table! What you put on your plate is between you and Holy Spirit. Remember, there are plenty of opportunities to refill your plate with different dishes along the way! At the end of the day, The Warrior Class is also *your* story and journey to write with God.

A brief overview of what we offer...

Training

The Warrior Class (TWC) is comprised of one main team with many different self-paced and specialty training options available, once Foundations Training (or Level 1) is submitted.

- Foundations (suggested timeframe 2-4 months – depending on the Stage)
- Level 1 – for those starting before Foundations Training was created
- Level 2 and Advanced Training – continued exploration of self-paced training and personal development
- Specialty Training (post Level 1 options – most are entered through an application process and includes Champion Training and Intel Development Training (IDT)).

Level 2

Every member progressing through our training is encouraged to experience our Level 2 training. It contains much of our prophetic and Intel training culture. Once completing Foundations (or Level 1), you are welcome to explore some of our Advanced Training Modules first, or step straight into Level 2.

- Level 2: New Testament Prophetic and Prophetic Intercession (3 Modules)
 - Module 1: Approaching the Heart of Prophecy
 - Module 2: Making a Prophetic Impact / Crafting Prophetic Words
 - Module 3: Prophetic Intercession, Intel and Crafted Prayers

Advanced Training Modules

All our members have free choice of exploring various Advanced Training Modules (ATM). Most people explore these modules for the suggested timeframe of 3-6 months, covering topics of a spiritual warrior, identity and prophetic/intercession. In addition, we continue to explore how God is opening up the creative process to undergird our training. For more information for each training level/module, go to our website and visit the “Training” and “How We Train” Tabs.

The Power of Choice

We believe strongly in the power of choice. What this means is you have the power to choose what you include in your training. Along with your self-paced training levels and modules, we have numerous calls to add additional support for your training. Calls will be on different times and days as we balance the many time zones represented in this global community. This means you may be able to connect directly or might get to listen to the recordings posted on Facebook.

We also offer specialty training to hone or sharpen you in certain areas of development. In addition, Intel Gathering (Prophetic Intercession) invitations come 1 to 2 times a year for all our members. The Crafted Prayers of Impact are posted in the Warrior Update and are updated for all of TWC to pray with one heart and one voice in our Intercession tab.

Intercession (see more in “Intercession in The Warrior Class section”)

We pray according to our Kingdom Assignments, not from a list of “prayer needs” or “prayer requests.” While there will occasionally be a real time call to prayer, prophetic intercession focuses on knowing what our targets are, what Jesus and Holy Spirit are praying and then collectively determining how we can best join them.

We are excited to continue to explore the expansion of our Intel process to include targeted prayer for people in many areas of influence. These Blueprints (Intercession Insights), are created through many stages. In each stage of the process, we steward, build and consolidate the prophetic we receive from all who participate. This process allows the prophetic to mature into a unique invitation of deepening for those who receive the Blueprints. Look for information and emails on when you will get to participate in this unique experience.

In Level 2 – is one area where you can get a better connection to our culture of New Testament prophetic and intercession. Specialized Intel Development Training (IDT) in prophetic intercession can be pursued to learn more and/or prepare yourself in how to help with the background of Intel.

Most of all, TWC is a place to practice and experience being a *joyful* intercessor, encountering the partnership with the Holy Spirit to pray with one heart, one mind and one voice together.

Why One Team in The Warrior Class?

Making the Most of Your Experience

Warrior Class is one large team of warriors, a tribe, who share a unified direction and purpose. Our coaches target their focus on each stage of your journey and story. With coaches who train, support and help you process your current training, you are able to tap into rich resources and people who are on a similar journey as you. We all love the learning and we are all learning.

Our coaches and leaders are volunteers who have taken their personal training and development into the area of coaching or leadership...in short, we are all learning, training, developing and growing. Each one is a willing and friendly resource for you! And each coach has a passion to encourage you simply because they have found so much life and encouragement in their own ongoing story and journey.

Note: We have updated our training and now call the New Member Process and Level 1 Foundations. For warriors who are in, or completed Level 1, substitute Foundations for Level 1 in what you read below.

The Purpose of Foundations

Acclimates you to The Warrior Class culture

Introduces you to areas of New Testament perspective and Kingdom thinking

Opens up Crafted Prayers of Impact and the unique landscape of Intercession/Intel

Foundations training welcomes you to The Warrior Class and supports your journey in language and culture of TWC. Through the Foundations, you are learning more about the perspective we gain as we partner more closely with Father, Jesus and Holy Spirit. You will also begin to understand why we view our training as similar to mountain climbing. The Crafted Prayers of

Impact and taste you get with our Intercession process helps you connect and hit the ground running even faster.

Foundations is your opportunity to discover more of who God created you to be and then see ways The Warrior Class best fits both your identity and the pace of your life. It is a beginning step. We have found the Lord continues to develop and upgrade our understanding of identity confidence throughout all of our training levels, processing and specialty training.

What comes after Foundations training? Greater flexibility in time, focus, pace of training, specialty focuses and community interaction.

After the completion of your Foundations Training, you can continue your self-paced training or apply for the more focused Champions Training experience (1 year commitment), specialty training or focus on Level 2 or your next advanced training module. What you decide to explore is your personal choice.

We give you the flexibility to choose how much of your time you invest in TWC. You have the freedom to balance the other very valid priorities of life, such as family, work or other ministry opportunities. Your powerful choice is to give your full focus on whatever percentage of your time you can allocate to your training and connection in TWC. The percentage will be different in different seasons of your life. If you have 10% of your time to allocate to TWC, then intentionally aim the full amount of your focus for that 10% on TWC. i.e. put 100% of your focus into the 10% you are able to give.

Your level of involvement and interaction in Warrior Class is your choice. We get to know the members that connect with us on Training or Engagement calls, Facebook, Connections Ambassador emails, emails to coaches and Training Days. We want to get to know you...so consider connecting with this community and your coaches on a regular basis.

No matter if you are an introvert, extrovert or ambi-vert, we have a way to connect. In addition, we encourage you to “get your brave on” and connect to other TWC warriors who can act as Warrior Class Buddies to encourage your journey.

Resources and Support

We trust you to decide how many resources or connections you wish to utilize in Warrior Class—and there are a lot to choose from! Remember *you are not meant to use them all, all the time*. Their purpose is to provide a rich choice of tools and services that you customize to fit your passions, focus, priorities and personality.

Here’s a quick overview of what we offer and how they work:

Warrior to Warrior

1. COACHES

Our Warrior Coaches are volunteers who love to share in the learning. They are here to provide:

- Training Calls on specific aspects of Training Levels
- Offer guidance for questions or insights that you prefer not to post on Facebook or for specific areas of your training process. (see emails below)
- Give encouraging, personal feedback on completed training levels or modules

- Post training support on our Facebook page

Our Warrior Coaches do *not* provide:

- Personal one-on-one mentoring or direct answers to all questions. Our culture of coaching offers ideas and resources to point you in the right direction in your own process of development. We are practicing the powerful questions that encourage your exploration, rather than trying to give you an answer.
- Individual prayer needs or requests. They often pray for you, but do not serve as a replacement for your personal friends and family connections for prayer.

The Warrior Class works on a group mentoring process and our coaches are continuing to train, learn, discover and grow. For more on group mentoring, you can read Graham Cooke's article on "Mentoring" in Training Journal 13 - The Nature of Exploration (page 15). **This is a key article in understanding TWC.** It is available on our Member Website, under the "Resources" tab, Training Journals.

2. ENGAGEMENT FACILITATORS

The Engagement Facilitators are fellow warriors who open a space for you to process your journey and story. Each one has an area of passion that acts as a lens to process your journey through for the conversations.

These facilitators are point people for the call (not coaches). Instead, they hope to offer a place of conversation and dialogue for you to discuss what God is doing in your life and how you are developing along the way with other warriors in TWC.

Our Engagement Calls are centered on a certain topic and are designed to give you and others space to process journey and story from the specific focus of that group. For example, if the focus is on Identity, you get the chance to process your story and training experiences from how your identity has been strengthened, challenged or upgraded. Then you can join another with another topic, like Fruit of the Spirit, and process your journey through that lens. You can join as many or as few of the Engagement Calls as you would like.

We have several Engagement Calls each month for you to jump on and connect. Find them on Facebook Events or [Access/Connections.../Training Call Calendar](#)

3. TRAINING CALLS

Join as many as you want...these optional calls are listed each month on Facebook and a master list for all calls is on the website. [Access/Connections.../Training Call Calendar](#). Choose the ones that will best support where you are in your training or in understanding TWC. Some, but not all call topics are repeated throughout the year.

We have many different types of calls. Our training calls are focused on expanded training on the topic and questions to support the training. They are led by our coaches and they pull from our self-paced training, their experiences and the revelation they have received along the way. But, all on the call are invited to share the gems gain along the way.

Barring technical glitches, we will post call recordings on our Warrior Class Facebook page. However, calling in live allows you to interact with others and ask questions, which is always valuable. We attempt to offer calls on numerous days and times so everyone (all time zones) has at least some available at convenient times throughout each month.

Get Your Brave ON! Sometimes, at the beginning of our TWC experience, warriors find it challenging to join a call. There might be a fear of saying something silly or not knowing how it all works. If that happens for you, see it for the upgrade opportunity it is. You can't make a mistake in TWC. You can have a new experience and learn! This challenge is a common obstacle and you get the joy of overcoming it. Take risks. Ask questions. Share your experiences. We love that!

4. CONNECTIONS AMBASSADORS

Connections Ambassadors are made up of coaches and members who enjoy encouraging others in their walk via short email chats. Our hope is that each member will receive an email from someone on the Connections Ambassadors team several times a year. This gives you a chance to share a bit of your story and ask any question you have not yet had a chance to post or email. This is a specialty training that is available to members after completion of Foundations. To find out more, send an email to twclass.member@gmail.com.

5. WARRIOR BUDDIES

Warrior Buddies are a way for you to share your journey with other warriors. The ideal group size is between 2-4. Most try to connect by geographic location, times zone or training level. Some meet face to face or via phone. Finding a Warrior Buddy is up to you. Just post your desire to find a Warrior Buddy on Facebook with your time zone and area of training focus. It may take a few tries as not everyone is on Facebook all the time. If you need more help in connecting with someone, let us know and we will try to help you. While we whole-heartedly encourage these connections, TWC is not responsible for the content, oversight or management of these conversation. We're trusting all of you to share responsibly and have provided suggestions for what these connections might include on our website under the Access/Connections.../Warrior Buddies tab.

6. TWC ANNUAL TRAINING DAYS AND REGIONAL TRAINING DAYS

We hold Training Days as an opportunity for our members to get together in one location and train. These are gatherings hosted by directors who create a conference/training environment so the larger group of TWC warriors come in from a regional geographic area. These gatherings include directors and leaders of TWC and will balance training, activations and relational connections.

Each year we have an Annual TWC Training Days. If you can only make it to one, come to this one, as we find these events typically release the prophetic understanding for our next season and are often memorial stone moments (significant, pivotal moments) for our community. These gatherings are open to guests -- How many guests depends on the size of the venue.

Training Days are typically a three day event, going from Thursday-Saturday or Friday-Sunday depending on the venue. They are optional but our members find them one of our richest assets. Friendships are formed and strengthened -- being together in the same room is a rare privilege that seems to always accelerate us into a new place in God. We always capture as much as we can in the Frontline that follows.

More information will come as we have venues and dates. It is a treasured experience. See the front page of this guide for the dates of the next Training Days.

7. TWC LOCAL AND REGIONAL GATHERINGS

These are informal gatherings initiated by our members to connect with other TWC members in their local or regional areas, usually with a focus on TWC fellowship, activations and

testimonies. They typically last anywhere from a couple of hours to a day, depending on distance traveled and location. These local gatherings are for our members to connect and celebrate all God is doing. Information can be posted on our general TWC Facebook page. Photos and stories of the day are welcome to be sent in for Frontline.

While we whole-heartedly encourage these connections, TWC is not responsible for the content, oversight or management of these gatherings. We're trusting all of you to share responsibly.

8. FACEBOOK

The TWC (Warrior Class) Facebook page is a main resource for questions and to receive coaching from the whole community. Your fellow warriors, coaches and directors are continually posting questions, insights and training videos. Our warriors post their experiences and transformation on these pages, too. Join the conversations! It's the place to share your discoveries and be encouraged by others. *Connecting on Facebook is very, very helpful to your journey and is a main form of real time encouragement and communication!!*

The TWC Facebook page is for all TWC members - though it is private and closed to anyone not a part of The Warrior Class. We want to be sure you get to meet people from every part of TWC and this is a great place to do it. It's also where we post updates or opportunities that apply to everyone, such as Training Days and real time prayer targets.

FYI - Facebook has become a significant part of TWC communication, prayer and training. You do not have to participate in all of Facebook to be part of our pages. Participation is your choice, but we want to be sure you understand that without checking our TWC Facebook pages, you will be missing one of our key forms of communication and community building.

Use Facebook to

- Ask your questions that other members can benefit from
- Get to know your coaches and listen to their video posts
- See training call reminders and connection information
- Hear recordings of recent and past training calls
- Share, read and comment on member testimonies
- Get time-sensitive updates and unpack scripture or get timely prophetic words/exploration for TWC from the Directors and coaches.

We kindly remind you that our TWC Facebook pages are not for:

Personal posts about family and friends that do not relate to TWC training or topics
Inspirational posts that do not connect to our training focuses
Personal blog links to your own sights
Personal prayer requests
Please see the General Use Guidelines on the website under Access/Facebook/General Guidelines

All of these are items for your *personal* Facebook page only, as our goal is to keep these pages focused only on Warrior Class topics. Thanks for your help.

Friend Requests/Warrior Buddies:

You are encouraged to “friend request” other TWC members so we can get to know each other’s lives and form relationships - however, you are completely in charge of the level of personal connection that you wish to pursue. You are not required to accept TWC members as “friends.”

Once your “friend request” has been accepted, you can use Facebook Private Messaging to send a personal message or exchange personal contact information. **TWC does not release emails or personal contact information.** Members are not required to respond to Private Messaging.

Let us know if you have questions on how you can use Facebook best.
We have some creative possibilities we can share if this is a new adventure for you.

8. FACEBOOK and other social media

The TWC Public Facebook page (Expressing The Heart of The Warrior Class) and our posts on other social media accounts, is a way we encourage the body of Christ. We post quotes and questions in the hope that you will share them on your own social media pages. This helps us spread encouragement, invitation to engage with God, and delight in the journey with the Lord.

It is also a way to share our blog posts and some of our member’s stories. It’s a great place to tell your friends to like so they can also share some of the wisdom and experiences we learn and share. You are welcome to post on/comment, like and share the content...it really helps us out when you do because this is one way we get to outreach to others and celebrate what God does for us! And TWC may just be the tribe they are trying to find!

A Wealth of Resources to Enhance Your Development

1. THE MEMBER WEBSITE - our #1 resource

See the front cover of this document for the most updated password and user name.

This is one of TWC’s richest resources! It is where we have TWC exclusive training tools available to you, so be sure to use it. We continue to update the website and will create tutorials along the way. We will post when those are available.

There’s so much here that we’ve found it helpful to give some recommendations for where to start. These are what we would consider our top resources to explore on NEW site:

Training tab and How We Train tab

We are in the process of creating video support for each of the Foundations Trainings in TWC. As we do, we will post them on the website so you can access them at any time. Before emailing questions to coaches, be sure you’ve checked this out. However, know our coaches are excited to help you out, even if it is in this Guide or on the Website...we delight in your questions. Other levels and Advanced Training Modules will continue to add video helps as we continue to grow - so keep checking back.

Past Intercession Updates and Frontlines

You will receive an email with each new publication, but to access older ones, you can find this information under the “Resources” tab.

Training Journals

These are one of TWC's richest resources - however, there are quite a number of them by now so don't try to tackle them all. Find a topic of passion or helps answer a question. Members are not expected to master the content of Training Journals. They are here to support you in key aspects of TWC.

Intercession and Key Territories

This tab on the website has some of our Crafted Prayers of Impact in one place. This includes prayers for our leaders and our most recent Crafted Prayer of Impact for TWC. If you have questions about "Key Territories" in our intercession, check out Training Journals 15 & 16 for more on those and how we use them in TWC.

2. FRONTLINE (publication sent through email)

Frontline is what we view as the cutting edge of where we are and what God is doing. The training articles released are based on our prophetic understanding of what is on the forefront of TWC and what keeps us engaged on the Frontline of the clash between two kingdoms. We have chosen to go deeper with the training in this publication, which means we are creating fewer training journals. Frontline is released monthly. It also shares various keys our coaches and members have discovered through experiences, self-paced training and training/engagement calls. It comes out through email and is posted on Facebook on the **2nd Friday** of the month. We archive them on the website under Resources/Publications/Frontline.

3. WARRIOR UPDATES (publication sent through email)

Where is the most recent innovation, opportunities, information and Intel shared in TWC? Our Warrior Update! It comes out on the 4th week of the month. The Warrior Update has the (literally) ground breaking Crafted Prayers of Impact for each Prayer Focus.

4. TWC SEASONAL AND BLUEPRINT CRAFTED PRAYERS OF IMPACT

These prayers are where we kick start the promises and provisions discovered through our prayer process. We have seasonal prayers developed from Intel YOU and other warriors have shared about TWC. We also have prayers from our Blueprints, just as we hand them over to the leaders behind each Prayer Focus. The Warrior Update contains our most recent training and information on Intel, Intercession and Crafted Prayers of Impact.

Intercession in The Warrior Class

As you know, one of the primary focuses of The Warrior Class is to raise up passionate and confident sons/daughters with a strong relationship with God and who carry a Warrior Nature to see Kingdom come to earth. In the process, we find intercession is a vital key to develop strong relationship with God and learn more about His heart. So, one of our main areas of focus is to develop joyful, powerful intercessors who know how to pray with God's answer, instead of just for an answer. (*Crafted Prayer* book, page 22).

Our Kingdom Assignment in prayer is different than most you've encountered and we want to give you time to experience it. The Intel process (prophetic intercession) is open to all our warriors. To include everyone in this invitation, you are randomly grouped with several others who are invited to join into each prayer focus/Blueprint process.

Information will be sent to your "group" when it comes up for the invitation to participate. These invitations will include the prayer focus, processing questions and a team of Intel coaches who

are there to help you with questions and support. The current process is a three week timeframe, divided into two parts of processing questions. We will send them out to your group along with a brief paragraph about the person/people of the prayer focus. Once you submit your part, it is combined with others in your group and goes through several more steps before it is sent to those leaders behind the prayer focus. We also have calls/videos to help you engage in our unique form of intercession and Intel coaches specifically trained in this area to help you. Contact the intel coaches through twc.intel@gmail.com.

This invitation will be offered to you 1-3 times a year through email. The prayer focus will change for each invitation and is explained in a short paragraph.

We do not offer a lot of information because we want to ensure we have the purest filters possible as we hear from God and desire to seek God's heart without bias for those who are more well known. The anonymity also allows any leader, famous in heaven, and maybe famous on earth, too, to receive a pure prophetic process without positive or negative opinions or judgements to cloud the information.

The innovation we have recently experienced through this outreach took our Intel to new places. The Lord has breathed life on it, taking the extensive training we have experienced since our beginning and allowing us to focus all our energy and passion to encourage, exhort and undergird Kingdom leaders (and communities) in all areas of influence.

Intercession Blueprints are a way where we give back to the Lord by carrying forward the legacy of partnering with promises and provision of our early training into this next step in our development as a community. The Blueprints and Crafted Prayers of Impact are a conduit of great encouragement to those who receive them, often described as a great gift or treasure in their lives.

OUR LANGUAGE

Because we have a unique focus on prayer, some of the language we use may be new to you. So to find out what we mean with the common words you will hear us use for intercession, see our website under the Intercession/Prophetic Intercession in TWC (and processing questions) tabs. Or go to our Quick Guide to TWC Terms under the Resource tab.

WHAT TO PRAY?

Initially, in Stage 2 of Foundations, your focus is on acclimating to our culture of prayer, becoming familiar with our Key Territories in Training Journals 15 and 16 in the Resources/Training Journal tab. You can also pray the Crafted Prayers of Impact in our Intercession section of our website.

As you enter Stage 3 and beyond, we look forward to seeing you engage in the process and adding your part. We collect intel all through the year for TWC and what you sense God is saying/sharing about it and our leadership. twc.intel@gmail.com.

Our unified Crafted Prayers allow us to pray with “one heart, one mind and one voice” regarding our Key Territories, promises other intercession assignments. You can adapt them to language that is authentic to you and of course, you can always pray as God directs. Sometimes our members will take one sentence, phrase or section and create a whole new Crafted Prayer of Impact focused on that one area.

Also check our monthly **Warrior Update** to find our current Prayer Points for any upcoming events or prayer targets. After completing Foundations, you can pursue additional Intel Development Training to become a part of developing different elements of Intercession in TWC. Watch for the training dates in our Warrior Update.

ORGANIZATION IDEAS FOR INTERCESSION

Many of our members create an **Intercession Notebook** of some sort. Having this allows you to just grab your binder for prayer times and gives you a place to take notes of what you hear and sense from God. They include sections for:

- Printed prayers from the **Intercession Update** each month
- Printed copy of Training Journals 15 “Taking Your Internal Ground” and 16 “Strategic Intercession” –We refer to these journals often
- Your own prayers and explorations in intercession
- Inheritance words/scriptures for meditation and prayer
- Any current prayer focuses/Crafted Prayers from TWC
- And whatever else you want to include!

You can keep **Crafted Prayers on your phone** - this is great for when waiting in line - or make a **Bulletin board** of prayers.

Joining Training and Engagement Calls Goto Meeting Quick Start Guide

We use a service called Go To Meeting for our calls. This is a video call service allows us to view each other and build connections. Although GotoMeeting used to limit the number of webcam videos to 6, it has now expanded it to many more.

There are four ways to join a call:

1. Sign-in to GTM at www.gotomeeting.com. Click on” JOIN A MEETING and type in the ACCESS CODE
2. Follow the [link](#) and prompts from Facebook Events or the email reminder and type in the access code.
3. Dial-in. There will be a number where you can dial in, if you are driving or have any background noise, kindly place your phone on mute and enjoy the call. The phone numbers can be found in the Events on Facebook.
4. We will send an email reminder to you with the link information in it each Thursday. This email will include 10 days worth of calls. For a more extensive list, connect to our Master Call list on the website under the Access/Calls... tab. Or see the pinned post on our Facebook page. Some of our training calls, such as writing Crafted Prayers or mining a prophetic word will need a bit more preparation time. This information is included in the template about each call.

Requirements: In order to join video calls you will need: A webcam (either built-in or external)
