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Who We Are



God's Yes and Amen!

As a group of dedicated pioneers and explorers, TWC is comfortable with stepping into the unknown. We see life as a Grand Adventure with God. We train to live a lifestyle of trust, faith, adventure and limitless possibilities. We listen for God's promises, then step into His "Yes and Amen."

And, we accept that we don't have to know everything before taking our first step. His gentle voice, telling us which way to go, is enough.

September became a time of activating this lifestyle for me and the Warrior adventurers* who journeyed with me. In June, a series of moves for three close family members, had me up to my eyeballs in moving boxes. Then, God put something in my heart. He simply said, "Highway 1."

I knew this was a California highway. My husband and I had traveled it from San Francisco to Los Angeles in 2018. And even though the road imagery was given as a figurative, prophetic understanding, I could see the territory God wanted me to travel. Through much prayer and a series of "Oh, soooo God!" events, this prophetic journey can be summed up in the words:

Kingdom Conversations

We rode God's wave. His "yes and amen" meant that every day we had specific Kingdom conversations culminating with a regional Training Days event. These conversations continued throughout the 15-day trip and included Warriors in TWC as well as people beyond our tribe.

The way God orchestrated this experience was nothing short of amazing. He released His "yes and amen" –opening doors and creating opportunities for us to share the heart of God, the TWC tribe and what we feel God is up to in this new era. We made the entire journey with no agenda and no expectation. Nothing more than our "Yes" back to God and the joy of a Grand Adventure. You can probably imagine the head scratching as people tried to wrap their minds around that!

Most are not used to this kind of Yes. They are not well acquainted with this type of exploration. Some cocked their heads to the side as if to say "What? Don't you want something from us?" Others were suspicious at first, wondering if we had some hidden agenda to promote ourselves or use them in some way.



As we shared the Highway 1 story, asking how we could encourage them and what they were seeing in this new era, God opened up something beautiful. We talked about what we sensed God is doing and heard their hearts for their areas of influence. Through the process, they discovered more about who we are, our excitement for TWC and what God is doing in this new season throughout all of the Church. We learned more about their Kingdom passions and gathered the new puzzle pieces of what they sense God is doing in this time. As we shared what we were coming to understand, a divine exchange occurred.

It was an incredible time of seeing God move! He was glorified. Borders and boundaries fell. Prophecy flowed. Excitement rose. We created a wave of blessing, encouragement, excitement and what ifs? We traversed from Northern to Southern California and wow! we were more than doubly blessed by what all these people shared, dreamed, prophesied and prayed.

Several weeks have now passed and I am still shaking my head and laughing joyfully at how powerfully God moved. Thank you for your prayers!

The favor God released for this trip has opened doors that no man can shut.

All of us in TWC share in that favor. We saw again that when God places something on our heart, we can safely take a breath and then step out humbly before our God. As we do this in His right timing, we will see every promise and provision has been wrapped up in His "yes and amen." See the Intel gathered from this time further in this Frontline. Good Bones and Strong Foundations: The Role of Training in TWC

The Warrior Class has a rich history of spiritual development prompted and accelerated by training. We have discovered that training brings transformation with new muscle memory in the spirit, soul, and body. And this amazing type of transformation means that the Self-we-are-becoming then governs our immediate reflex and response in any given situation. Our TWC training today is still designed to bring about this New Creation transformation— through Biblical revelation and relational experience with God and with other TWC members.

God's Word is our baseline for true New Creation living. The New Testament is rich with illustration and instruction to show us the Majesty of God and how to love like Jesus loves.

In each Stage of TWC's **Foundations** training, the Word of God is front and center.

Other materials have been incorporated to expand perceptions and clarify understanding, including the teachings of Graham Cooke, Shawn Bolz, and Leif Hetland.

At every level Activations are a key component in TWC training. They enable us to practice real intimacy with God as Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and to deepen our trust in the Goodness of God. TWC members' relationships, developed on calls, at events, through buddies, and in connection groups, also provide opportunities to practice the Kingdom principles of New Creation life. We become what we behold in God and in others.

The TWC training process begins with the member completing an assigned submission that is then sent to a coach for review. This is the process in place from Foundations Stages 1 & 2 through our Advanced Training Modules. We have established for ourselves a land that is safe for exploration. There is no possibility of failure, only space for deeper revelation and transformation.

Everything focuses on our intimate relationships with God. Sometimes Holy Spirit directs a member to move on to a new territory. Sometimes, Father God knows that our relationship with Him will increase and expand best with further exploration in the current territory or space.

You can trust that, as they prepare their response to each submission, TWC Coaches are taking their role very seriously, being very intentional to hear God's heart for each member and to share what the Lord is providing for that member.

The first two stages of Foundations training lay the foundation and process that we build upon.

Foundations Stage 3 focuses members on their personal relationship with God as Father. The Old Testament is our guide in the exploration of Who Father God is and how He does things.

Stage 4 focuses members on their personal relationship with Jesus, applying New Testament scripture to investigate His' nature and how He did things.

Stage 5 focuses us on Holy Spirit and the amazing partnership we can develop with Him.

Stage 6 is a culmination and wrap-up of the previous three Stages.

Now a bit about timing and flow of the training process... Training Stages 1-6 are sent out individually and are to be done in order. They have been developed to work together and establish each Warrior Class member on a rock-solid foundation as a Son or Daughter of God, as each explores spiritual and emotional maturity, many embrace greater maturity and confidence than when they began the TWC journey.

Just remember, intimacy with God is His greatest gift to us and it is our greatest weapon against any enemy. To ensure that we continue to grow in His likeness and power we view our training as a lifelong pursuit. Once all six Foundation Stages are completed, more wonderful opportunities are opened for exploration. You will find information on these on the Website under "Training and How We Train".

Side note: For all TWC members who have completed Level 1, you have the option to begin exploring Stages 3-6 as Advanced Training Modules even before finishing Level 2. There are activations and valuable content in these Stages that were not previously included in Level 1 and have been designed to deepen your trust in God and strengthen your emotional maturity.

With Deepest Thanks

As I think back on our Kingdom Conversation, "grateful," "thankful," and "inspired" are three words that come to mind. As each conversation unfolded, God highlighted colorful puzzle pieces for us to gather along the way.

Everyone I met with agrees God has shifted us. We honor our brothers and sisters who have the divine assignment to hold the line of the last age until the rest of the Church can make the transition. For those at the forefront of this transition, we can deepen our understanding of what God is releasing in this time. As we do, we can help others in Christ better prepare and embrace what this shift carries.

With much prayer and with the Lord's help, I hope we can get a better picture of what this new era holds. Sharing with you is a way to say thanks for all those who were so willing to open your doors and give time to me and my fellow Warriors (Connie, Susan, Judy and Ellen). Thank you so much for your generosity of time and conversation. It's easy to see your passion and how God is moving in and through you. I hope it was the first of many conversations to come.

Highway 1 Expanded

As a reminder, the whole journey started with the Lord placing the phrase "Highway 1" in my heart. Early in the morning a few days ago, He woke me up with this expanded revelation.

<u>High</u>: God's taking us to a higher, deeper, place of relationship with Him. We are called to press into deeper abiding and rest as this new era continues to unfold. To be better givers, we get to continually become better receivers of His love.

Without continued personal growth in these areas in Him and encouragement of those around us, we will burn out too quickly.

<u>Way:</u> In the battles Israel encountered while taking their Promised Land, God encouraged them to fight differently. The instructions were unique. They advanced for God and toward His promises, but <u>how</u> they applied their skills depended on God's direction, not on what they had done in the past.

Each new battleground brought out different skills, equipping, application and ways to stand/fight in faith. Each battle also prepared them for what was to come.

This New Kingdom Era begins through reconnection to, and foundational grounding in, God's nature as highlighted in scripture. The shift includes seeing the foundations of our faith with fresh eyes. New and creative ways of seeing through His heart in this time and season.

We can align and assess as we ask two main questions:

- Lord, how can my relationship with You expand and deepen?
- What needs to be removed, tweaked, shifted or changed (in me or in my area of influence) to make way for this new application?

1 = Unity: Unity is key. We each have differences in how God asks us to apply our skills, gifts and talents. Yippee!

God may place us on the battleground as scouts or as trainers. Others may be positioned to shore up defenses and expedite the healing process, others may draw more in or have an eagle or strategic perspective, etc. But ALL are positioned according to God's placement for us in this time and season. <u>All positioning Is Valued</u> and equally important in Father's eyes. Each placement is purposeful for the Kingdom to advance on earth – let's stay humble, grateful and appreciative of what each brings to this Kingdom movement as we prefer one to another. Let's remember we all have a part. No matter preference of denomination, parachurch, creative application, etc. honoring each other and the fact that we are all believers in Jesus grounded in scripture will be key to seeing Kingdom brought to earth.

<u>Overcoming Borders/Boundaries Mindsets</u>: Boundaries created through fear and human territorialism are to be overcome. It's important to hold people who are part of our ministries loosely so God can position them, or reposition them, where they are needed. Our trust in God's provision for us may be challenged. But, His nature as an abundant Father who is our Provider will always be present.

Will we have more to add or refine? Absolutely! This is a starting point. It in no way includes the 30 plus hours of conversation encountered along this "HighWay 1" Journey.

Key Pieces Highlighted Through Our Kingdom Conversations

New Era/Age/Time

We are in a new time/era, rather than a new season of the last age. It has begun and we are in a place of transitioning from the old to the new.

Relationship with God

Holy Fear of the Lord is at the forefront, built upon the freedom and permissions of friendship/identity in Christ.

It seems a paradox to consider Holy Fear brings about more freedom, but the depth of this submission to Him takes us to an expanded place of relationship, permission and authority in Him. This age includes a call to deeper "holiness" through purity, sacrifice (counting the cost), character, humility, and maturing. Maturing and living from our Identity in Christ is key. This rests on the foundation of a deepening, ongoing, and growing relationship with God.

Focus and submission to God's Majestic nature keeps us in a constant state of wonder, awe, worship, and exploration - opening the creative process needed in this time.

Our passion for God opens a "thin place*" through us, where the veil is narrow and heaven comes to earth.

*A thin place on earth is a space like Moravian Falls or places in the UK where so much prayer and worship have been poured in, the veil between heaven and earth is thin. Biblically, Jacob's Ladder...Genesis 28:10-22. Mt Sinai is another and is represented in scripture throughout Genesis and Exodus. People experience many different encounters in these places. We become a thin place when what we carry, such as anointing, changes things around us. To be thin places, means we learn to live a life so connected to God, we remain in a place of abiding in Him. As we do, we ourselves become the thin places as we carry heaven with us and bring Kingdom to earth.



Transformation

The Church goes through major transformation

- Historically every 500 years (1 cycle)
- Every 2100 years sees a complete revision of relationship with God. Adam to Moses, Moses to Jesus...Jesus to now.
- We are in the place of transition from one to the next.

The Church will be challenged to transform to what it is to be and become in this age. We must assess truth of new vs old wineskin.

Leaders

- Purity, Character, Emotional Maturity are vital. Unhealed wounds are our greatest internal obstacles and will sabotage our best efforts to unify.
- Maturing Fathers and Mothers -- it's time to take our places. Insecurity and fear overshadows opportunity to see others rise. Kingdom Identity based in who we are, not in position or role.
 - Consider: If the role went away, would you still be able to describe your identity in the Kingdom?

Body of Christ – The Bride is rising,: equipping, empowering, launching... Consider: What is our part and what is God's?

Transition and Reposition

Many of us have experienced major transitions in ministry, relationships, life and living. God changes our "how" :

- Openness to see what still needs to shift in these areas
- Preparation includes continued renewal of vision (see High and Way in opening letter)

Our personal transformation means relationships will change*, adjust, or be created for us to step into our new era. *God already moves to bring reconciliation and restoration for relationships lost.

Honor and Humility

- Honoring Fathers/Mothers of the Faith, while still encouraging our creative expression
- Equipping of the body
- Value the strengths each person/leader/group brings to the table. Differences make us stronger together
- We each need each other. We each bring different perspectives and understanding. It's important to ask, encourage and explore* in God together.

*Personal agendas are counter-productive unless developed and unified through Christ and Father's heart. Question: If I stepped out, would the momentum still continue in my area of influence?

Application/New Wine Skin

Applying our Christian foundations is different in this new era. The "how" has changed.

Creativity

Creativity is at the forefront. Freedom to think creatively. God is releasing creativity to impact the "how." Consider all options and ideas.

Battleground within the Church – Transition From Performance/Function to Kingdom Living

Fear Based thinking verses V Kingdom Truth

- Fear will motivate status quo and drive stagnation
- ✓ Favor, creativity and grace comes to those humble and submitted to God for Kingdom impact.
- Isolation/Protectiveness of areas of influence is an indicator of fear based motivation
- ✓ Unifying synergy forms in cross pollination and diversity of conversations



- Some will hold to old wine skin and may rise up against those who are filling the new one with the new wine
- ✓ God as defender Be unoffendable and resist taking the offenses of another. Quick to forgive is key. God may ask us to remain silent in these moments.
- Some local churches fade away many believers feel disconnected, or "dechurched", even when actively attending.
- ✓ God is opening creative avenues of community and connection.
- Immaturity and insecurity provide footholds for the adversary of old. We will face the religious spirit on many fronts. Accusations and misrepresentation will be common.
- ✓ Confidence through growing relationship with God seals off footholds. By preferring one to another, placing relationship (knowing each other) at the forefront, and maturing in God we disempower this spirit.

Consider: Who are your running mates? How well do you know them? Do you and they place relationship as a priority or is it functional only?

Important Scriptures:

Mat 28:18-20 ¹⁸ Then Jesus came close to them and said, "All the authority of the universe has been given to me. ¹⁹ Now go *in my authority* and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. ²⁰ And teach them to faithfully follow all that I have commanded you. And never forget that I am with you every day, even to the completion of this age."

2 Cor 3: 18 ¹⁸ We can all draw close to him with the veil removed from our faces. And with no veil we all become like mirrors who brightly reflect the glory of the Lord *Jesus*. We are being transfigured into his very image as we move from one brighter level of glory to another. And this glorious transfiguration comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.

Ephesians 4:11-13, 16, 32¹¹ And He Himself gave some *to be* apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, 12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, 13 till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ;

16 from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.

32 And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.



If you have ever struggled in your training or wondered about some of the questions listed below, you are not alone. All of us have had to stare them down at one time or another. Learning the lifestyle of a Warrior means we will each have to address the enemy's lies and deal with our personal fears and insecurities and learn, instead, to recognize and move forward in God's truth.

At times, our adversary will move in and begin to whisper things that cause us to question our value and our participation in the training process. But once we step into that place of abiding again, we realize he's a liar who is just trying to stir things up. The great news is that God can turn anything for our good, including an enemy attack!

"(Sigh) I can't do all of this!" "Everyone else is getting this better than I am." "If there's a problem? Hide!" "If only I could receive direct mentoring...."

On this page, you'll find encouragement and responses for some common thoughts/concerns we all experience. You can expect these thoughts of insecurity and personal performance to cross your mind as you continue through the TWC training process in TWC. Just recognize them and partner with God to upgrade your thinking. What are you wrestling with and what is your "instead"?



Training Focus

In the Old Testament, the Hebrew people would erect piles of stones as a memorial to something their God had done. To commemorate their experience, they often gave Him a new name such as El Roi - the God who sees (Gen 16:13), Jehovah Shalom - the Lord is Peace (Judges 6:24), and Jehovah Jireh - the Lord will provide (Gen 22:13-14). They wanted to remember what He had done and Who He was for them.

In the New Testament, Jesus asked His disciples to remember what He was going to do to memorialize Who He truly is. He is our Salvation, the Bread of Life, the Blood of the Lamb - our Sacrifice. All of this meaning is captured in the Lord's Supper, the disciples' "memorial stone" of a meal of Bread and Wine shared while remembering their Lord. As Believers in 2019 we have the blessing of being able to do the same. We too can remember and give thanks for Who He is and What He has done for us.

Take a few moments to reflect on what God is doing in you and for you in your TWC training.

What name would you give Him in your current adventure or exploration?

More importantly – Who is He being for you?

God is Who He says He is. He does not lie. He is a promise-keeping God. Whatever stage of training you are in, it is always about your relationship with God - Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Know that you are His child (identity) and welcome His embrace of relationship (intimacy). And, as you explore Who He is for you, know that the perfect response to His amazing presence is Praise. Praise Him and His nature – bless His name for Who He is for you right now, in this moment.
