Words Matter

When words around the globe describe what God's been speaking to us for many years, we have to take a minute to praise Him. It's a moment of pause to recognize the beautiful picture of His prophetic heart and previous nature. When our words line up with God's heart, we find language that captures our transformation.

A lot of people are talking about a "new normal" right now. We look back just a few short months and realize some things may never go back to the way they were. What if God's taking this opportunity to bring more of us into His "new normal?"

God spoke about a new normal many years ago at the beginning of our Tribe. His heart was to help us step into "normal" kingdom life – an established normal for heaven, a new normal for us. We began a process of prayer and stewardship of prophetic revelation that radically transformed us in every way.

We have come a long way. Just as our words help us define our identity and commission, our language reflects our culture and defines it.

We still have a lot to discover, but the Lord is faithful. Words have been on our hearts for a while. We have a value and principle that was established in the time of our foundation (see below). Through this value and principle, we hoped to find language that describes our journey and story with God: fresh language, easy to understand and free from religious predisposition.

We did not want to assign defining language too fast. To quickly use words to define TWC would have created limitations based on what we knew, rather than on what God was doing. Instead, we gave God time to speak identity and commission over us. Going on the journey with Him as He took us step by step through upgrades and revelation.

With this New Era, we are in a season where these words are bursting to life. We can capture who we are and describe our why and our what.

- ~ Our why? We can boil it down to one word: *Intimacy*. That's it. It's that simple. In a phrase: **We develop intimacy with God and heart connections through God.** We encourage and equip each other to have deeper relationship with all aspects of God's nature. By connecting through heart rather than function or titles, we find more authentic relationships through our true identities in Jesus.
- ~ Our Who? We are Warrior Ambassadors of God's Love. As emissaries of His heart we celebrate the multifaceted diamonds we are as we display His light in a myriad of colors colors we carry and reveal as the light of Jesus shines through us.

The mindset of a Warrior to loves greatly. Many people discount the power of love, thinking it is something fleeting or merely sweet. Love is transformative. It is an unstoppable force that reconciles and restores. Loving well requires fortitude, joy, resilience, choice, and sacrifice of self. Warriors choose love. Warriors know how to love as God loves, with forgiveness, choosing to see others through God's eyes and heart.

~ Our what? Our commission helps others find their unique commissions in God. We know the core of a commission centers around relationship with God and others and through true identity. Relationship and identity are precursors to commission. Our identity and depth of relationship with God activates us to authentically live out promises, gifts, talents, skills, and permissions from God through our own commissions.

As we mature, our language reflects our stewardship of all God gives us. We cease to feel a need to prove ourselves or find value in things of this world. Instead, we find our worth is found through Him. The new normal of learning kingdom life becomes an established normal in our lives. Our commissions merge together to see His glory spread to the ends of the earth as we speak of the transformation power of His love.

A New Normal



The Culture within our community is part of God's new Normal. "What is normal?" is a good question that is only answered within a given culture.

Anyone who has gotten married knows that no matter how well you think you know someone before you get married, joining two family cultures into a new working family unit requires grace, patience, and lots of love. You are each part of God's family - creating a new Kingdom Family Normal in the here and now.

When a person steps into TWC to explore our Kingdom culture, the experience can be just as challenging. What do they mean by a possibility? Rest as a weapon? Or Capacity? TWC language is focused on the Kingdom of God and how God thinks about things. You can find more information on TWC language on the Website under Resources/Quick Guide to TWC Terms.

These words mean more than their definitions. They reflect our alignment with God and His heart of Love for this planet, especially the people on it. God is moving in our midst, and over our lives, in the chaos around us; realigning the world to Himself.

TWC has many prophetic words, including our Now and Beyond Blueprint, that focus on our part in God's current culture upgrades. We, through our language and actions, are part of His plan to bring His Kingdom to Earth. Jesus is honored as King, and Holy Spirit power is a visible part of everyday life.

In John 9 the story of the Man Born Blind is shared where Jesus, the Son of God, is beautifully displayed. This man had been able to hear and touch the world around him, but not see it. Jesus steps into his space and time and nothing is ever the same. The man can now see. When reading through this story, especially in the Passion Translation or the Mirror Bible, it is delightful to hear how this "seeing blind man" talks to those who are "blind seeing men."

He speaks with such courage, knowing in his being what the truth is. That is what an encounter with Jesus does. He went from being a beggar, to risking his connection with his culture to speak truth. His life will never be the same. He walks as a new creation seeing Jesus as Who He is.

In TWC, our culture is about alignment with God and how He thinks. Our training brings encounter taking us to deeper places of truth and knowing Jesus.

- How have you encountered Jesus?
- What truth do you know without a doubt?
- How might the Lord be asking you to share that truth?
- What might be needed for you to partner with Holy Spirit so the truth you know is covered in the Love you have been given?
- How might your encounters with Jesus be bringing you into a New Normal so that your life is never the same? Are you ready to "get your brave on" and say "Yes"?



VALUE: DEVELOP A NORMAL KINGDOM CULTURE

Principle: Use authentic, common vocabulary that is fresh, contemporary & free from religious predisposition.

Action Plan:

- Upgrade church language to Kingdom language in all documents and communications
- Encourage each Warrior to go through their own religious language to cull out any words that are religious or reflect old mindsets. Avoid trite, meaningless/vague, cliche expressions.
- Speak and write decisively & strategically rather than poetically.
- Our language reflects stewardship, not ownership

Training Highlight Foundations Stages

Foundations Stages training was launched in 2019. It is helping us step into the New Era.

This expansive training guides our newer members on an amazing journey of intimacy and Kingdom living, full of identity exploration and learning the riches of God's nature. These trainings also have the potential to take our seasoned members on deep dives into God's heart for what is ahead in relationship with Him and others.



There is an upgraded level of partnership with God that is unlocked in these trainings including a greater clarity in hearing. Each one provides opportunity for more freedom in friendship with God.

God makes sure this community has solid foundation on hearing God's heart. Stage 3 explores Father God's heart, Stage 4 goes into Jesus's life and gift. Stage 5 jumps into Holy Spirit's power. Stage 6 wraps it all up with a look at living from Kingdom inheritance as Sons and Daughters of God.

For those of you in Foundations Stages currently, receive the message that God's heart for you is to know Him and His love for you. He delights in you simply knowing Him better. Through the encounters designed in the training you will see Him as He is and from that place you reflect His glory. Continue on at the pace that fits you, knowing that your training submission is simply a snapshot of where you are, not a finish line.

For those of you who have *not* stepped into Foundations Stages trainings because your TWC training started with Level 1, the same is waiting for you with more breadth, length, height, and depth. These trainings build on each other in order, but for those training in Advanced Training Modules or Specialty Training Tracks, you may explore Foundations Stages in any order when you finish your current training. Consider taking a Foundations Stage out for a spin to see what God might have for you in it.

As you think about your training process, you might consider how your training connects to your personal devotional time.



How is your training is impacting your other relationships? What aspect of God's nature is being revealed by your training? How does Who God is for you impact your every day?

Connect the dots between your training and your life challenges right now. God may be showing you exactly what you need for your now through your training.

The Kingdom Language of Love By Kathy Brown



"If I were to speak with eloquence in earth's many languages and in the heavenly tongues of angels, yet if I didn't express myself with love, my words would be reduced to the hollow sound of nothing more than a clanging cymbal." (1Corinthians 13:1)

In the Now and Beyond Blueprint for The Warrior Commission, sent out in early 2020, we were given an incredible invitation to be a "Kingdom bridge to unconditional love and freedom in Christ" -- A Kingdom bridge to the Bride and Body of Christ and to the greater world around us – His Kingdom.

Being a "Bridge" enables us to be a connection from one place to another place. This connection imparts revelation of unconditional love and freedom in Christ. How do we do this? How do we step into this identity and walk with the heart of Jesus for His people? How does our language authentically reflect the love and freedom of Jesus, honoring those we are speaking with? Are we communicating the heart of God? Do those hearing it feel loved?

1Corinthians 13 goes more into depth of what love is. Expressing ourselves in love is reflected in how we communicate heart to heart, and in how we listen and speak to those around us.

Listening is an important part of the process of communicating and a powerful tool. Listening communicates love and honor to people. We listen to the words someone speaks and in that listening we enter into their world, looking to also hear the heart of God for them. Compassion rises as we listen. Our perspective changes and comes into alignment with God's. This is where we ask Holy Spirit what He would speak to their heart through us.

The words we then speak, coming from our heart aligned with the heart of the Father, brings people into an encounter of God's presence imparting love, truth, and freedom. This is the essence of the prophetic, imparting the heart of God to His Beloved. What an awesome honor and privilege we have in partnering with God in this way!

To Him be the glory forever and ever! Amen!
