At some point, stillness comes in; first a stillness of actual physical existence, then a stillness of soul

and spirit, even if what is seen in the natural is not still.

Intimacy comes when you are simply sharing the same space. Depth is found, width is explored, height is seen, breadth is felt.

Our relationship with God becomes more than our cognitive brain can put into words, but we eventually do. Thoughts are transformed leading to agreement with the provisions and promises of God.

Majesty resides in the transformation which takes us beyond what we could have expected or often imagined. We have permission to live a Kingdom life for which God provides.

Kingdom life changes life on this planet beyond what we see with our eyes or feel in our humanity. Kingdom life is New Wine life where we learn to think and act like God's Son, Jesus. We are

resourced in this life, though maybe not in what the world says is important. God knows what we need and want, giving it in His perfect timing.

Intercession as a Lifestyle



I had a negative perspective of an intercessor. It was this person who was bowed-over, boney fingered with a “burdened” frown on their face. Frankly, with that image in my mind, I had no desire to become that person. In fact, I did pray, but I also rejected the idea of being an intercessor like that. My perspective was based on what I’d been taught based on a poverty spirit idea of intercession.

Did God have an instead for me about abundant intercession? You bet!

Fast forward to now. I can joyfully say, I am totally into intercession. I love it. I have discovered God’s abundance in it. I have opened up to intercession, so it is an ongoing and active part of my lifestyle.

What changed? I did.

Jesus has this incredible way of shifting our thinking. He draws us into a more accurate view, His view, of what things really look like through His eyes. Through this lens, everything we do in Him, with Him, is an act of intercession. All things become a form of worship for our King.

Could it be that my worship is also intercession? It’s true.

I am worship. Intercession is my lifestyle. It’s not I am about something I do. It’s who I am. It flows from my relationship with Him. Intercession comes from His heart. To “do” prayer means I separate from

connection with a majestic, creative, all knowing and all-powerful God. “Doing” prayer as an obligation, and separate from relationship with Him, in its purest form, speaks to disconnect. It’s the same as saying, “I will work very hard, throwing stuff up at Him, until I get it right and “make” Him move on my behalf.” That’s more about manipulation than partnership. It’s exhausting.

Can I pray with a pure heart if my intent is to force God’s hand or manipulate the circumstances? I can’t.

My intimate connection with God’s heart helps me connect to Him. I become partnered with what He is praying. I interact with what He is releasing. My words, heart, actions and worship tap into His for whatever His focus is in those moments.

One experience opened my sensitivity to Him like never before. I was in India at a woman’s conference. Worship began. Our team

spent hours creating long streamers of fabric. Mine was red and gold. I had never used one before, but something drew me to step out of my box during the worship time.

Could I find the courage? I danced.

I danced up and down the aisle. From the back of the room to the front, I twirled and danced and waved that streamer in the air. Then I danced to the back of the room again, waving this banner of covenant, freedom, and purity over myself and over the women and men who were there. It was powerful. I worshipped and prayed over those men and women. Freedom came that day in worshipful intercession. Something opened up in my heart that never closed again. Prophecy, Intel, and passion bubbled up in me like an underground spring that had burst through the surface of my soul. I would never be the same. My view of Intercession changed. Intercession is worship.

What was my heart thought as I broke out of my box? I'm free!

I thought I would hold onto that flag. It represented a place of freedom I never wanted to lose. But, a few days later, I felt God ask me to give it away. That banner was put in the hands of another. This symbol of freedom in intercession was handed over, never to be seen by me again.

Yet, was it really lost? It's here.

I have that freedom in me, never to be lost. God spoke of the gift my banner was to that person. Worship is not worship unless it is poured out. Intercession is not about limitations or things withheld. Worship and intercession are wrapped together, in one package of sacrifice, praise, partnership, and passion. They cannot be limited because they are not of this world. They are meant to be released, freely given, and joyfully shared.

What did I discover through sacrifice about living a lifestyle of intercession? I'm empowered.

God empowers me to bring change through prayer, just as He empowers you. In reality, intercession is worship and worship is intercession. They come out of the abundance of God in our lives. As we embrace that abundance, we find freedom. Freedom opens up growth, maturing, and joy. We step into the Warrior mindsets that draw on the nature and heart of God. We are relentless in our prayers because they are found in ongoing conversation with God. By shifting intercession from a moment of something "done" into a heart posture, the transition to a lifestyle of prayer was simple.

How do we grow to experience freedom in intercession? God's transformation.

All is poured out in prayer and given to others. It is connection with God, freedom to be free, dance, expansion, and delight. Intimate intercession is a place where sacrifice pours out, pours in, and hopes. The heart of God in me, through me, in you, through you for a situation, person or people group.

How does it feel to have a lifestyle of intercession with God? It's amazing!

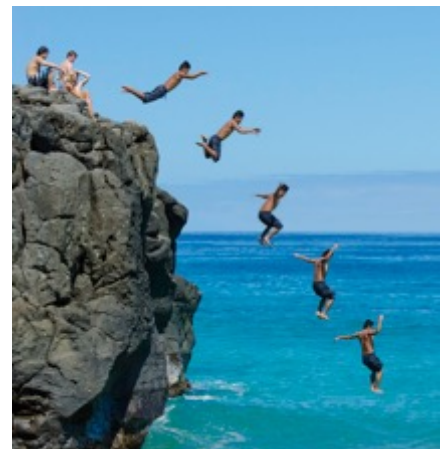
