As Warrior Ambassadors of Love, we can live out Kingdom principles for life and relationship. Believing the best, being present – future focused, and choosing to be joyfully vulnerable; all come from being In Christ, It doesn't come from simply making ourselves behave better. When our outward interactions flow from our spirits, alive in Christ, we carry more than good behavior.

We carry the light and sound that brings revelation of God's goodness. These revelations from God's heart for each of us are being woven together, creating the

tapestry of our individual warrior journeys: small streams that merge into a great river.

Our great TWC river of revelatory lives shared in relationships -- whether with a Warrior Buddy, a CoNexus Hub, or one of the various Conference Calls hosted by TWC leadership, or a myriad of other ways -- give you a chance to see others' stories around you.

Action Plan:

- Facilitate present/future dialogue using Identity Statements
- Use Facebook & social media for connection opportunities.
- Connect with Kingdom minded leaders in all areas of influence through our Blueprints and Crafted Prayers of Impact.

VALUE: JOY, FUN & LAUGHTER ON THE JOURNEY

Principle: A company of people who reflect the joy in becoming more like Him.

Action Plan:

- We laugh at our own mistakes and embrace the encouragement of God and friends.
- Teach, model and train joyful vulnerability to the Goodness of God in every battle.
- Connect with each other when possible, often at conferences or designated TWC events

VALUE: BELIEVING THE BEST IN OTHERS

Principle: We speak to the treasure in others and purpose to see them as God does.

Action Plan:

- When realignment is needed, it occurs in the context of potential and encouragement.
- Encouragement is defined as seeing others as God does and expressing it.
- We allow room for unique processing styles and development of a self-paced rhythm for progression through our training and in TWC.
- Our specialty training takes a different approach to sharpen skills and hone specialties.

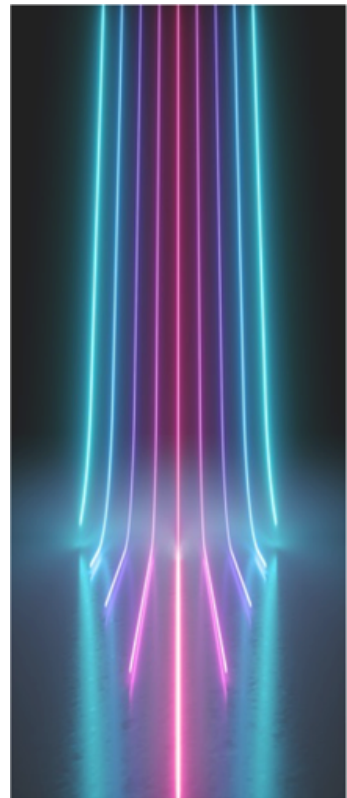
No Boundaries - Replay!!!

As we talked, I noticed a lady kept watching us at a nearby table. At first, I thought we might be annoying her with our continual laughter...well, guffaws as tears rolled down our faces...if you really want the truth of how much fun we were having.

As we got up to go to a more private place for the sensitive intel part of our conversation, she caught my attention. I went over to her and asked if everything was ok. She had tears in her eyes.

She said, “I’ve been watching how all of you were talking. I saw how you treated each

other and how much fun you were having. You see, I had lost hope that the Church could really look like. I didn’t think believers could enjoy each other in such a deep heart felt way. I got healed just by watching you talk and hearing your laughter. I have hope for the Church again.”

Wow. I never would have imagined God would move through the joy we had for the journey in such an impactful way. We loved each other, preferred one to another and wanted to celebrate each person’s story and journey.

It’s such a natural part of the our TWC lifestyle, we forget that not everyone has had that experience.

Our time together on calls, on Facebook or face-to-face, is how we celebrate the Goodness of God. He’s fantastic and He’s a part of who we are. We are stronger together.

Authority in the Kingdom is Relational

The word ‘commission’ is so rich! One strong aspect is the sense of team leadership that is embedded in that word. My workplace is guided by a Board of Commissioners, and I have served on non-profit boards. These all use a team approach to lead.

Our God also uses a team approach! We see this in Genesis, for example, when He says, “Let us create humanity in our image.” And in 2 Chronicles 18, Yahweh invites the host of heaven to offer their ideas for how to achieve His will. (By the way, what if right now Papa Yahweh is asking your angel-friends for their ideas for the best ways to bless you?). And Jesus says, “If you ask me anything in my name, I will do it” (John 14:14).

Wow...He invites us into His process!

One of our TWC values is that we are “a prophetically inspired relational community.” Relationship is one of our top priorities, and out of it emerges kingdom-style leadership & authority.

When Jesus’ disciples asked him how to pray, the first thing He did was invite them into His own relational space with God – using two powerful words: “Our Father.”

In the kingdom, leadership – and the authority that comes with it – is highly relational. The better you know Him, and let Him know you, the more His leadership emerges within you. And when we link arms with others, our tribe carries a higher level of authority than any one individual can.

Christine & Sharon exemplified this team approach during Training Days – it was a joy to see them lead us together, each preferring the other, as they both shared what they brought to the table.

I believe that the Church and society are emerging out of an independent mindset (totally natural in the adolescent stage), into the inter-dependent mindset of mature spiritual adulthood. If we choose to accept this commission, we will become mothers & fathers leading relationally and capable of shifting culture at all levels.

Exchange is Delightful

In The Warrior Commission training each member explores their identity in Christ as a much-loved child of God. Through Inheritance scriptures, prophetic words, and life experience we mine treasure from God and unpack revelation. Within this community, we have a safe place to explore, discuss, and learn new responses to life based on what God says and His love for you. Jesus has the authority to redeem anything, especially the picture you have of yourself that does not line up with how God designed you.

In Christ, our emotions, feelings, and thoughts are transformable. Even our bodies basic reactionary emotions can be transformed, like when a child is afraid of the dark or sounds in the night, but as they grow up and learn what safe really is, the dark or new sounds don't bring fear, just curiosity.

Don't condemn yourself for your emotions or feelings. Take them with you into the secret place of conversation, receiving from the Lord, so you can give back to Jesus what you don't need. Then you can receive the Kingdom emotions Holy Spirit brings through you. The exchange will be delightful.

Know that you have a space and territory here within our community in which you may practice who you are. Your interactions with fellow warriors become a both/and as you give grace and encouragement, and you receive grace and encouragement.

The Lord will help you with what you need to know to partner with Him in your own transformation. Your TWC training, from Foundations Stage 1 through Specialty Trainings and Advanced Training Modules, is designed and developed to create space in your intimacy with God, to behold Him as He is and become like Him. You will grow up so that what bothered you before, is no longer an issue. You can be curious, not afraid. You begin to behave as who you are in God's eyes.
