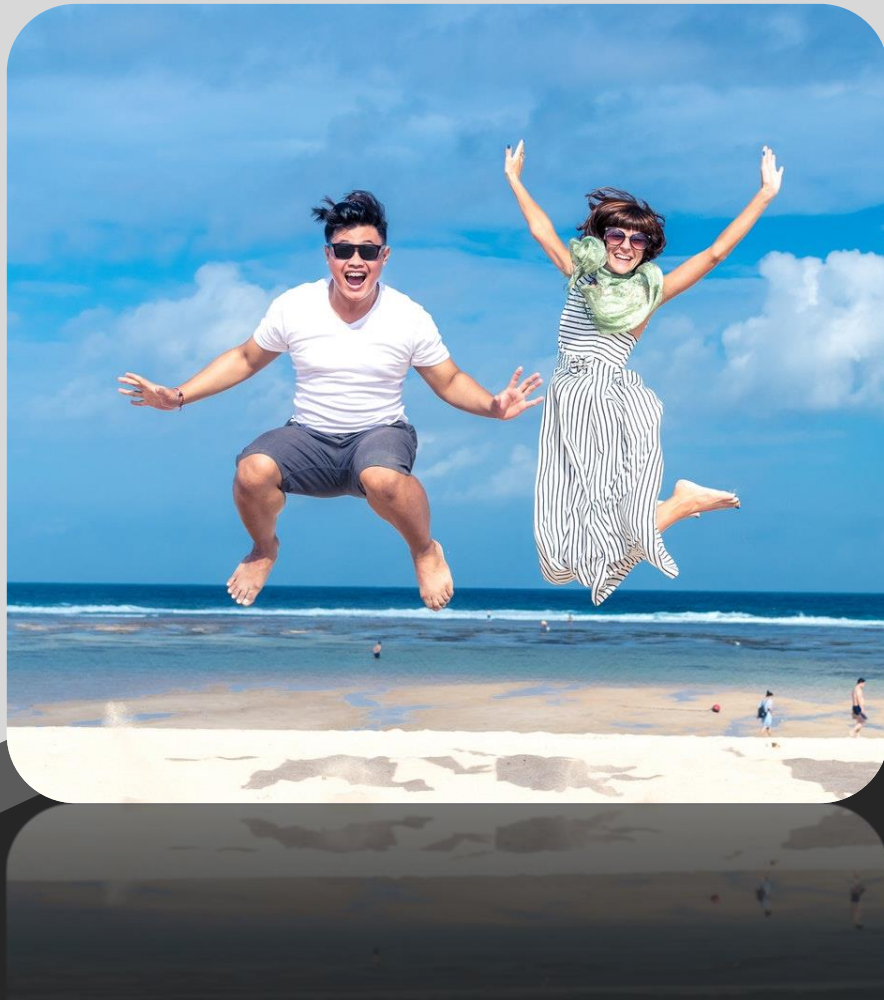

CARRYING JOY

While making coffee in the kitchen I had been pondering the statement “I have decided to be a lover of the nature of God and a carrier of His joy.” This decision for all of us as TWC Warriors was very personal to me this day. I do love the Nature of God. I’ve been learning about Him since a little child and been studying Him for over 30 years. I love His nature – goodness, kindness, a 1 Corinthians 13 kind of love; full of compassion, gentleness, and a giver of hope. He provides when there is not visible provision. He heals, releases, and redeems.

The Carrier of His Joy part was the hiccup in my thought processes. His joy is in me because He is in me but what does “carrying it” mean?

Upon checking definitions of the word “carry”, I began to see the word differently and understand what my part of this decision was. Holy Spirit and I were on a journey of exploration and discover for my life. What I was reminded was that there is no way I can make His joy happen, be visible, or tangible to another - that is a Holy Spirit work. Maybe that’s a no brainer for some, but for me it was a fresh revelation. I began pondering what that would look like.

I had been thinking of the word in terms of the action of carrying, what I was supposed to do? The Lord showed me I am simply to be the container of the joy.

A carrier can be a container. His joy in us spills over the top and pours out of who we are. The more my focus is on His Nature, the more this overflow simply happens. His design for us is to be carriers of Him, kind of like a carrier of an illness, or a passport. He is on us and in us and that cannot change.

As a Warrior, being a lover of the nature of God, *you are* a carrier/container of His Joy. You have the potential to infect everyone around you with Who He is. Who He is releases Joy. You are not responsible for it being received.

You have the possibility to go to many places under the law with a passport in hand. Embrace your privilege of being a carrier, loving God’s nature and totally letting go of the outcomes. God produces the outcomes. Your part is loving His Nature, giving Him permission to release His joy out from you, whether presenting your “joy passport” or releasing His Joy infection as He directs.

What does God want you to know about being a *carrier and a lover*? How is Holy Spirit defining the word for you? He loves to take us on adventures of discovery. In your training, or your devotional time, ask God what He wants *you* to know about who you are in Him. Does this decision impact your identity? What might be possible as you embrace your being and becoming in alignment with this decision? What are your returns as you are a carrier of the assets of His Nature and His Joy?

TRAINING: EVIDENCES OF TRANSFORMATION

Our Training in TWC makes space for God's transformation. TWC helps you with the transitions those transformations bring as we become more like our First Love. We are not seekers of information, but seekers of the Person, Jesus. Encounter with God always leads to transformation to be more like Him. Evidences of Transformation are a way to record and remember this transformation and are part of our Values and Principles.

Value: Transformation through beholding God and becoming like Him

Principle: Facilitate both knowledge and encounters with God that result in transformation of language, thinking, behavior, perception, faith, and works.

The encounter facilitated by the Activation in a training module leads to a process. What does this mean for me? What do I do with it?

Space is created for new mindsets, new behaviors, and new defaults in alignment with God's heart of love for you and others. Everyday life can also be a catalyst for encounter, and the process is quite similar. How is Holy Spirit directing you to transformation? How might this new default be expanded by practice?

Most training modules in TWC, beginning with Foundations: Stage 3, has a section called Evidences of Transformation. This is divided up into perception, language, behavior, thinking, faith, and works. Each topic gives you an opportunity to document a change in your life that reflects that area. You write out an instead statement that concisely describes an old way of life and the new way of life that has replaced it. Then you are invited to share a brief story describing what that looks like in real time in your life.

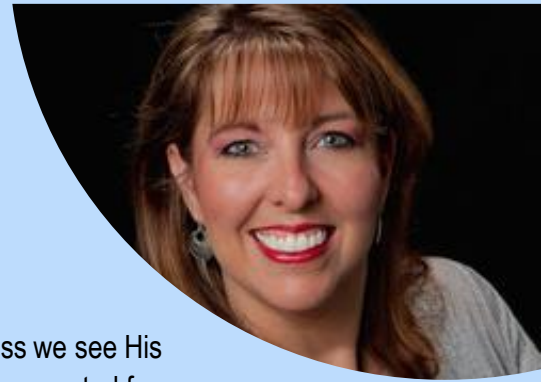
It is helpful when you begin a training to take the concepts of Evidences of Transformation into consideration. In your Warrior Notebook, where you are keeping notes or journaling about your Warrior journey with God, you can create space to write down the transformation you'd like to see. You can also jot down what God has highlighted that He is bringing forth in your life. As you see change, or others mention they notice the change, write down what Holy Spirit shines light on along the way. Then when you are at the end of the training, filling in the Evidences flows out of these notes taken.

God loves to create opportunities for you to practice this transformation and bless the new defaults you are developing, and you will love walking with Him being more like Him.

Lovers of God's Nature

In the light things are revealed in us. Some are incredible, some need to be overcome and scattered away from us. Yet, in this choice to be seen, God's joy is revealed. He points us to the beauty of who we are in Him. He uncovers what has been hidden but is strong enough to stand in the battles of this life. As this revelation pours forth, God creates more space for the light of His love to shine in us.

We realize that our greatest invitation is to abide in this light. But if God is light and God is love, then His love is a light that scatters and shatters the darkness within and without. Darkness cannot exist in light, so with every new invitation we accept of His love, we see a greater infusion of the light of His love in us. 1 John is a fantastic set of scriptures to explore.

- ❖ 1 John 1:5: This is the message we have heard from Him and announce to you, that God is Light, and in Him there is no darkness at all.
- ❖ 1 John 4:8: The one who does not love does not know God, for God is love.
- ❖ 1 John 4:16: We have come to know and have believed the love which God has for us. God is love, and the one who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him.

The first heading under this tab is Prophetic Intercession in TWC. This contains a wealth of information as to our Intel process and even a rich processing activation for exploring prophetic intel process. This is worth some time discovering what is possible.

I have two younger brothers; Wu went home in 1982 after surgery. David lives in Berkeley with his wonderful family. I love visiting them for Chinese New Year, while there I am cared for wonderfully.

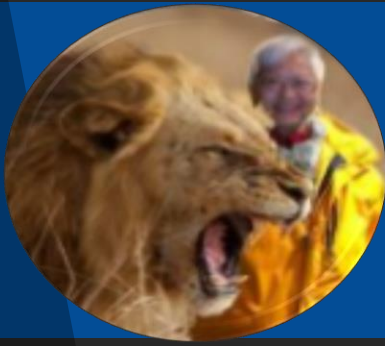
You probably already notice I use the word "Wonderful" a lot - that is the first thing in the morning I tell myself. As I look in the mirror I will say, "Wei, you're beautiful, you are wonderful." Ha-ha! I will say it again. "I am beautiful, and I am wonderful." The One who lives in me is wonderful, so, it is a reality for me.

I knew the Lord when I was 11, I wanted to be a missionary and trained as a lay missionary in Brussels, Belgium, from 1963-1968, then upgraded my nursing to be a public health educator. Came to Canada in June 1968, working with Indian Affairs at First Nation reserves as a nurse practitioner. Did everything that needed to be done; dentistry, sewed up wounds, X-ray technician, delivered babies, even had to sign birth and death certificates. Exciting 24/7 work! Learned native life, including eating bear and moose, and ice fishing. Enjoyed wholehearted hospitalities and love. I met Ed in 1970, as we both worked for Indian Affairs, me in Health, Ed in Education. In 1973 we moved to Toronto to look after Ed's Mom until she went home in 1986. We have no children; a lot of people call me aunty and grandma. A marvelous place to be. No diapers to change, just love and be loved.

I have a banjo, noisemakers, and flags for worship. I love taking risks, enjoying new food and adventures, and love to be quiet with the Lord too. That may be why I am very energized since this lockdown. Just need one change - to see people face to face, miss hugs. I would love to join mission trips again. Volunteer more. God completely healed me from MDS through the power of communion - I take it every day. I have been soaking continually in Love. Love For me it is the most important part of my life. Knowing that I am total, unreserved Loved, cared for, carried continually as in Isaiah 46:3-4.
