Steward the Blessing

As we grow into mature sons and daughters in Jesus, it is interesting what the heart of God does to draw us deeper into His heart, into deeper intimacy with Him.

We learn that being in a place of “*hiddenness*” is just as -- or maybe even more profound in our relationship with God -- than in being in a place of “*manifestation*”. **The intentionality of God’s heart in pursuing us leads us into this place: all that matters is our intentionality towards pursuing Him.**

In my own journey with God, I learned this important value of “The one with the One”.

For over 30 years my husband and I led worship for our small fellowship. Leading worship was my great joy and passion. I had the incredible honor to create an atmosphere with God that led people into the Secret Place and then watch what happened as they encountered the majesty of His presence.

Being a worship leader, I was used to being in front of people and connecting with the presence of God in that place. I was used to the warfare that would happen and the challenge of sometimes feeling like you are the only one worshipping in a room filled with people. What an incredible and awesome experience it is to see what happens in a room of people when Jesus walks in!

Then Abba asked me to lay it down. He asked me to step out of leading worship and to just be in my home with Him. He asked me if it were enough that I would worship Him without anyone else being present. God called me out into a time of hiddenness with Him, into the quiet place that no one else sees. Only God and me.

During this season, my husband would go to church and lead worship, while I stayed home. I would bring out my guitar and sing to the ONE. To the only One that matters, I would worship my God. I could feel my heart expand as I experienced the great JOY it gave my Father God that I would worship Him ALONE. In this Holy Place the presence of God would again fill the room and I would dance with Him and the angels. Even though at times it felt lonely, I knew that what God was doing in me at this time was massively important. Everything that I am, that I live and do is about Him. What is truly eternal is **God with me.**

In the place that no one else sees is where true transformation happens. Our heart is purified as we intentionally pursue God without anyone else knowing about it. God’s invitation to more of Him is to us alone. We are the only one who has the power to say our “Yes” to Him. Our heart is only for Him.

What If...Stewardship is Both Being and Doing

Our Decision That Defines Us focus within this Frontline is:

So, let's enter into an exploration of the concept of Stewardship. Some of what comes next may have you nodding your head saying, "Yeah, I knew that." But you may also be challenged in how you think of stewardship. It will be a great discussion to have on the Forum! Can't wait to see your post...

What do you think of when you hear the word "steward?" Most of us probably think of tithing. What if we could expand that definition and consider it as an all-encompassing word or concept?

What if...Stewardship is both being and doing?

We could see it as "being" because it helps us be in Christ, opening our hearts to Him and receiving from Him. We steward our time and focus on Him. Then we steward – play with, explore, dive into, process, journal, research, talk about, etc. - that revelation until it becomes part of who we are.

Stewardship is a doing because it is how we activate, or steward, what God has given us in those times. We steward, or put actions, to concepts and upgrades.

The story of the talents is a stewardship story, but so is Jesus disappearing away from the disciples and the crowds to spend time with God. Jesus stewarded His time to be relational with God. He was intentional to spend time with others, pouring out on them.

Jesus also stewarded relationships. He made time for others. He chose to value who they were and where they were in their journey. He heard what they had to say.

The next morning, Jesus got up long before daylight, left the house while it was dark, and made his way to a secluded place to give himself to prayer.
