We have decided to live as a visionary community focused on group mentoring and New Testament leadership valuing who we are in Christ.

A NEW ERA VISIONARY COMMUNITY

This month focuses on the Decision That Defines Us as a visionary community. What is a visionary community? Why is group mentoring an important part of our visionary community? What makes New Testament leadership so significant in this time?

A New Era focused visionary community moves with the inspired prophetic direction of God.

A vast difference exists in following a vision and being a visionary community. Following a vision, even if originally inspired by God, includes the temptation of making the vision come first. In a vision first culture, the vision becomes the priority everyone in the group is supposed to support and sacrifice toward that vision until it is reached.

In the last era, the vision was a rallying point for people. It was a training ground for people to connect and find direction and purpose. A vision in a hierarchical church framework helped people feel like they were part of something that tapped into their area of passion.

The challenge the Church faced in that era is that carrying the vision was in the hands of one person or, at best, a very small group of leaders. The main portion of the group was not included in the vision's ongoing prophetic development. As following the vision became more prominent, it superseded how people were treated in the group. With leaders who were solely vision focused, people in the group became the means to the goal and creative expression was limited. In extreme cases, the leader ran with the vision but stepped out of partnership with God, losing sight of some of the key shifts needed for the fullness of that vision to be realized. As a result, the vision often became the most dominant focus. How well someone followed that vision was the litmus test for if someone fit in the group.

A New Era focused visionary community is flexible. The whole design of the group is fluid to accommodate sensitivity to how God moves and the direction He leads season by season. This type of community includes opportunities for all voices to be heard. This may not happen all at one time but is an ongoing process of collecting and stewarding the prophetic that comes in through the day-to-day life of the group. The overall vision is replaced with group identity, Kingdom assignments and a value-based culture. God releases vision for each step along the way that is often more seasonal but aligns with these values.

The inspiration of the Lord is intentional and includes a developmental aspect for those in the group. Because the prophetic direction is uncovered through conversations and connection, heart to heart relationships are a foundational part of the group. These relational connections move beyond the function of "making" the vision happen to living the vision as part of who they are.

Our Warrior lifestyle becomes an outflow from the overflow of the deposits already activated in the group. Being visionary is more about understanding the next stage of development for the group and how that overflow pours into others. In other words, the focus is more about movement than accomplishment.

Conversations, often brought out through group coaching and mentoring, uncover real time prophetic inspiration. Collective wisdom is mined as God releases it through the people.

Group mentoring/coaching is an important part of a "visionary" community for two reasons: 1. Personal development accelerates when we have a multitude of counselors in our lives. 2. Training in a New Era culture cultivates New Era, maturing leaders. When activating in areas of passion and casting prophetic vision based on deep prophetic relationship with God, New Era leaders are visionaries who connect and live out God's plans. Over time, they help others with the revelation of living a visionary life with God – both in TWC and with others.

Ongoing training in this type of visionary Kingdom culture means our Warriors have safe opportunities to develop, grow and practice many different aspects of voice and value. This practice ground builds confidence to explore the creative process of prophetic inspiration. You each become a different type of New Era leader, or influencer. Self-confidence gained as a Warrior Ambassador of God's heart translates into impacting, shifting, and changing the world around as us as we partner with the Lord – even if that means we enhance, expand or shift things in TWC!

The word visionary includes both the prophetic inspiration we get from God and the exploration and pioneering that comes from passionately pursuing God's heart. With intimacy in God and heart-felt connections with others as our key passions, we seek to explore what God has for His rising Warriors. His limitless heart, dreams and plans are all available for us to explore the visionary aspects of who we are in Him.

The seasonal vision in *The Warrior Commission* is always inclusive of people being our goal, rather than people being a means to an end. For us, that visionary value is a both/and. Both for people beyond our current membership and for our Warrior family. For example, one outcome of this visionary culture includes what is captured and shared with others through our Blueprints. What we have been given, we readily and joyfully share. But stewarding this passion of God's heart also encourages the growth and development of our own Warriors, too. We train, grow, deepen, and then carry what we have learned in our Intel training ground to others in our areas of influence. Blueprints were an authentic next step in our growth, but also part of God's specific visionary design for TWC. They also include tailored visionary design for those who receive them.

As each Warrior connects to many different types of mentoring and coaching, God matures and encourages each person through a multitude of perspectives, anointings, voices, experiences, growth stories, journeys, etc. That is also how prophetic inspiration for us, as a whole, is shared and collected. We take that information and, at certain times of the year, pull it together. We create an Impact Prayer and pray it together. We also use that information to recognize how God is moving, what may need to be created, expanded, or established in us.

What an incredible promise! Jesus was such an amazing leader. He saw what was needed and made a way for it. "You will have what you need when you need it" was included in those words He spoke to the Disciples 2000+ years ago. We have that same promise. He knows what we need and makes a way for it.

The synergy between Jesus and Holy Spirit is beautiful to behold and step into. You have reality planted into your life and Holy Spirit will reveal that reality to you. It is the reality of what life is in Jesus. All of this is to "prophetically" (God's visionary revelation) let you know what is to come, even for your own life. God set things up so that we are able to explore and discover His plan for us, individually and corporately.

Within TWC, our leadership style is modeled after Jesus continuing this future focused way of life. See each person as who God made them to be. Share what is needed when it is needed with the focus being on Jesus. Provide space for each one to not be alone walking or processing life in God.

This journey into leadership, another word for stewardship, within TWC is about dependence on Holy Spirit, seeing what God is up to, and being like Jesus. That leadership includes embracing the concept of group mentoring. We have others with whom to travel on this road into the heart of the Father. Jesus always travels with us, and we also have others on the journey as well.

So, what has the Lord shown you about what is ahead? What has been planted in you that He is revealing to you? Who has He brought into your circle to walk with you on the journey? Have you considered why it matters? What a difference it makes to have community that gets these concepts and supports each other in the day-to-day of life. In this space the transition is doable and even enjoyable as we move with God to wherever He is going.

TRAINING: LEARNING WITHIN TWC

Found

Have you ever been listening in a conversation and then you realize the prophetic is manifesting? Even if it is only one word, sound, or picture? A group of Warriors were talking about what we see coming in the future for TWC. Whether it was for ourselves, or the whole community, or even both, we shared our words. One Warrior apologized that that she only had one word and she wasn't sure what it meant. That word was, "found."

Someone else said they heard "stamped or sealed" and those words were related to our commission. It was significant to think about this brief exchange. Three words that led us to discovery. Each of us is finding our path in TWC, the world, our life, every phase possible. We have been in a major state of transition, and we have become "transition specialists".

As this back and forth went on I blurted out "I have been found." The questions came to me. Was I lost? What made you realize you were lost? What made me realize I was found? Sitting with the Lord, seeing if He will release more understanding and maybe this exercise will release more. I have learned that when I get vulnerable with a healthy dose of humility, He likes to enlighten me or others. It all begins when we don't rush to do, but we desire to hear. We don't rely on that first word we hear, and we seek to go deep. Funny thing is that can all happen in a split second.

In that the simple phrase, "I am found" a realization came that expresses my process in TWC. My identity statements, inheritance words, voice, purpose, why, commission, I am the beloved, Father's heart, intimacy, process, gifts, tools, leader, champion, coach, warrior, IT person, authority, filling roles I never thought I would, dreams and so much more. This culture, this community, and I, found me and I am home!

One of the beautiful mechanisms of the prophetic is that singularly or as a group the word found may have many different values. It is like when I saw myself as the beloved there were no words to describe the knowing - unless you know. It is the same here. When we give up the doing and concentrate on the being we know what it is like to be found.

WEBSITE HIGHLIGHTS – Places to Explore

Reminder - Check out the TWC Identity Statements. If you follow the trail from TWC Kingdom Culture, to TWC – Who We Are, then TWC Identity Statements you will find them. As you read them, know that since you are part of *The Warrior Commission*, these are your identity statements, too.

Adjustment - One adjustment that you will find when you access the *Forum* on the Website is that the Welcome screen now contains training videos for using the Forum.
