SEEING GOD'S GOODNESS

Recently, I returned from a trip to France. It was refreshing, enriched by time with family and an ongoing conversation with the Lord. These words and phrases kept returning to my thoughts as I wandered around the grand halls, museums and buildings that have stood the test of time: Remain in Him. Walk in Him. Steadfast. Resilience. Patience. Love. Endure.

Early in the trip, I received correspondence from two friends. One had lost a two-month-old grandchild due to physical complications. The other had lost a husband to Covid. They each are questioning God's sovereignty and their faith is shaken.

Receiving both emails within a few minutes of each other, along with several other serious prayer requests, I spent some time considering how our Decision for this month relates to these situations. In a world where we are surrounded by loss, how do we carry compassion and hope others long to know? When we face grief so great, we cannot stand upright, or our hearts are so heavy emotions crowd out our ability to receive from God clearly, how do we abide and remain in Him? How do we, like those buildings I explored in Europe, endure, and stand the test of time?

God is all around us. He is omnipresent (everywhere). Yet, we go through times when we do not initially feel Him or understand His direction. Our Decision to be Champions who abide and rest in Him contains within it a powerful choice. This choice keeps us connected to God in the hardest times of our lives. Through this connection, God empowers us.

Choosing to abide in God includes humility toward Him. It incorporates a discipline of realignment when distractions or emotions pull our focus away. Our Warrior training and Warriors in our Tribe encourage us in those moments to remember God will turn all loss into a space where His glory will be revealed.

One of the ways His glory is found, is through our experiences of how God empowers our resilience. When our face is buried in His chest and our tears drown out His whispers of comfort, we may feel alone. Yet, He is with us, holding us, growing us, healing us, and preparing Kingdom strength within our Champion heart. Resilience comes as grief gives way to hope. Healing comes as we lay down whatever we held as dear and give it (or them) over to Him.

The fortitude we need surfaces. We rise as Champions who are stronger, more compassionate, and fierce in our love. Abiding becomes a lifestyle for us as Warriors of His heart. In Him all things are found. In Him, we are empowered to face all obstacles, find His truth, and remain steadfast on the Rock of His heart.





Running to the Battle

“From then on half of my young men worked while the other half stood guard with lances, shields, bows, and mail armor. Military officers served as backup for everyone in Judah who was at work rebuilding the wall. The common laborers held a tool in one hand and a spear in the other. Each of the builders had a sword strapped to his side as he worked. I kept the trumpeter at my side to sound the alert.”
(Neh 4:16-18 MSG)

The Presence of the Lord was sufficient for that man so long ago and it is sufficient for us. Christ's delight in our walking provides more than enough for us to walk, to learn to step in sync with our King. Consider taking time to look for where the Lord is standing. How many steps will it take you to get to where He is? Is running an option? You might need to warm up before taking off in a sprint. How might He be directing your steps? Is there anything for you to carry? How is He having you support His battle plan?

Abiding involves being close enough to be a part of the action, but safe in the rest and peace of the Love of God. What a grand adventure! Even though we are living in a time like Nehemiah where we are holding hammers for building in one hand and need to have a sword ready in the other hand because the battle is heating up, how might your New Testament abiding impact your building and partnering with Jesus' battle plan? Pondering has a powerful propensity to prevail God's presence in our lives. Pondering, an old English term used by craftsmen, originated from pounding out or making smooth a piece of metal to ponder out the rough spots.
