God's Special Forces Training

Jesus modeled a way to live God's Kingdom here on Earth. Then, when He left Earth to go back home to His Father, He did not leave an instruction manual. Instead, there were 11 men - plus a group of more - that stuck together until Holy Spirit showed up with better than an instruction manual, Himself. Jesus had poured into these people so they would know who they were and have examples of how to live God's Kingdom on Earth. They were loved and they were ready. Holy Spirit showed up to activate all that Jesus poured in. John 14 -18 shares part of how Jesus helped them know they were ready, even if they might not have *felt* like it.

The readiness of the disciples was directly reflected in their willingness to stick together and wait for Holy Spirit. They had one directive before setting out to conquer that commission, wait for Holy Spirit. The disciples took that directive, followed Jesus' example by praying to the Father like He told them to in John 17, and waited on God's timing. They became special forces, bringing a movement that is still going 2,000 years later. Each one walking out their individual assignments while staying connected, even without the internet.

Special Forces implies a better chance of victory because of the training. They are sent to take care of what is beyond ordinary. The term implies *force* – energy to bring movement. Those disciples brought movement sitting in a room together praying, living out submission and partnership with their King. They loved Him so much, and He taught them what love really was and is. Then the fire of Holy Spirit ignited what Jesus had deposited. What movement might we bring as we embrace loving Him like He loves us and receiving our individual commissions? Jesus is depositing into each of us through life and Holy Spirit is already in us to ignite those deposits for us just like He did for them so many years ago.

We have an invitation to receive the deposits and partner with Holy Spirit for those deposits to be lit on fire. And what a fire it is and will be. Each one a city on a hill that cannot be hidden. And yes, when God knows the time is right, we each will be seen as the Special Forces that we are and accomplish His mission.

TIME TO SLAY A GIANT

He looked gangly and awkward, carrying all his art paraphernalia up the museum's steps. He had always felt awkward in life and watching him struggle with the gear 'caused one to understand why'.

His parents attempted to promote sports and signed him up for a summer basketball camp when he was eleven. That lasted about a day. Gangly, awkward, and uncoordinated don't mix well on the basketball court. They felt as sorry for signing him up as his attempt to dribble, much less shoot the thing.

His grades were never above average and never below. He seemed like an awkward average kid, most likely growing up to be a self-conscious average adult for all intent and purposes.

Leopold was his name, but he went by Leo, "for obvious reasons," he liked to say. Leo was a third-year art student at Washington University in St. Louis, Missouri. The University was located across from the West side of Forrest Park, where the 1904 world's fair took place.

In the park is a fine art museum where Leo often congregated with fellow art students to study the works of past and present masters.

Putting pencil or brush to canvas began not long after his excruciating excursion into basketball. Christmas of his eleventh year, his folks ordered an art set. There were pencils, chalk, watercolors, brushes, a pad of large drawing paper, and an easel.

If sports were his 'fish out of water' experience, art was Leo's 'It's good to be home feeling'. He took to it quickly and never looked back. Friendships developed in the art community, and now at University, he began to thrive. As a highly introverted person, Leo found no joy in sharing his art with the public.

He didn't mind a few creatives taking in his works, but considering displaying his pieces in an art gallery, or even scarier, would be a solo show. That gave him sweats and shakes, "That ain't gonna happen!" Until he sat with one of his professors.

She understood Leo's passion for his art. How it's more than applying paint to a canvas. It pours out of his very core. From the deepest part of him. As if some force is driving him on!

In their discussion, she pointed out his limitation of displaying his works and challenged him. I'm assuming you guessed the challenge.

"Leo, I want you to go to the steps of the art museum. It has to be there. Please set up and paint the statue that stands out front. It must be the steps - no hiding."

Leo about died that day. Not physically, but his mind, heart, and soul tore apart. "I wonder if it's too late to try basketball again," joking but not sure it would be less painful. Today is the day. He woke to having trouble finishing his morning coffee thinking about the idea, much less pulling off this herculean internal feat.

This moment of choosing to face the anguish is when Leo knew he could do it! His desire to paint was more significant than his fear of someone criticizing his art.

It didn't change anything. Leopold still looked awkward and felt out of place, but his desire and passion for his art overcame the internal anguish.
