BEING FILLED WITH ALL THE FULLNESS OF GOD

God's fullness is much more beyond what we can imagine! He is El Shaddai, the God who is more than enough! Fullness is to be filled to maximum capacity. What if God wants to enlarge our capacity in Him so that He can fill us with His fullness **beyond** what we can imagine in the natural?

"That Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith, that you, being rooted and grounded in love may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height – to know the LOVE of Christ which passes knowledge **that you may be filled with all the fullness of God."** Ephesians 3:17-19 NKJ

This is an invitation to explore with Jesus the multi-dimensional LOVE of God! His promise to us in this exploration is to fill us with ALL of His fullness. Beyond the natural, His love is supernatural! In His spirit with our spirit we can meditate, explore, and discover the vastness of His love! Let's enter into the kingdom like a child and imagine!

Imagine yourself looking out over the ocean from a high place. You can see that the ocean goes beyond the horizon, farther than we can see with our eyes. You can also see the curvature of the earth and the open sky above. Look up at the clear blue sky, how high does the sky go? Can you see beyond it into space? Does it ever end? Look at the width of the horizon of the ocean. As the earth curves, it continues beyond what we can see. Look straight out over the ocean, imagine how far it goes. Then imagine the depth of the sea. Some places still too deep to be explored by man.

Now in your spirit's imagination, ponder on how vast God's love is even beyond what we can see at the ocean. Can you see how wide Jesus's love is? How long? How deep? How high? Meditating on the vastness of God's love in this way, what is happening in your spirit with God? Are you being stretched? Is your capacity being enlarged in the spirit?

What is Holy Spirit doing inside you in this meditative place? His supernatural love fills us as we go beyond our human limitations to our spirit's unlimited capacity with Jesus. A sense of wonder and awe of the magnificence of God's fullness fills you. Practice this meditation and see what happens inside you! It is God's great pleasure to give us His kingdom!

TRAINING HIGHLIGHTS

The question coming to mind is How does TWC training help us receive and stay in this fullness. TWC training modules are designed to help you dive deep into God's goodness and His desire to be in relationship with you. There is a unique balance in our lives, no matter what our personality type or emotional bent, between our intentionality in relationship with God and our relationships with fellow humans, whether believers or not.

We need the interaction with people because God blesses us through them; that's how He created us. These relational connections are simply a shadow of what is possible in our connection and interaction with our Father God in Heaven. He went to great lengths to reconcile us to Himself. We have Holy Spirit pointing us to Jesus and that reconciliation, and we have Jesus reintroducing us to our Father and Creator.

All the training within TWC is designed to support and enhance your journey and connection with Father under the expert support of Holy Spirit. In that journey, as you learn more about your Creator and Father, you learn more about yourself, and vice versa. Making time and space for this relationship makes all the difference in walking out life in God in fullness.

Whatever Training Module you are exploring, you are encouraged to not treat it like an academic course, but as a key to aspects of God's heart that He wants you to see and receive for yourself. Each training module has information and activations that are unique to TWC. Academic process often is not helpful because God is looking for relationship and conversation, not right answers.

You may find that incorporating your TWC training in your devotional time will help open it up for you in new ways. What if your training journey is a form of worship and an intentional pursuit of an increase in faith? What if your relationships within TWC are enhanced by your training in unexpected ways? What Can I Explore in Worship Ebb?

Continue to Pray: God's plans will come to pass. He's not been surprised by this past year. In fact, He's moving in mighty ways! Coaches Corner: STEPPING OUT IN FAITH...

Now faith is the reality of what is hoped for, the proof of what is not seen. Hebrews 11:1

What does it really mean to have faith? What are we called to have faith for? How does faith actually work in a tangible way?

Faith is when we believe the word of the Lord (whether written, spoken, or revelatory) enough to act on it prior to seeing any evidence of what we are believing for.

Heb. 11:8-9 "By faith Abraham, when he was called, obeyed, and set out for a place that he was going to receive as an inheritance. He went out, even though he did not know where he was going."

Abraham heard the word of the Lord, believed it, and acted on it prior to receiving any proof that it would come to pass. There are a few key components here to consider.

Abraham had no doubt that what he heard was the word of the Lord. If you feel the Lord is telling you something, there are several ways to test it. The first and most obvious is to see if it lines up with scripture. Is it in line with the character and nature of God according to his written word? Can you find examples in scripture of people who God asked to do the same thing you feel He is asking you to do? If the answers to these questions is 'No", it is not the word of the Lord.

Abraham obeyed. He knew the Lord was asking him to do something, and he chose to trust God's revelation to him and act on it, knowing that God would provide all that was necessary to bring the word to fulfillment and give him the promised inheritance.

Abraham picked up his stuff and set off in a direction (presumably God told him which way, or perhaps there was only one option available) not knowing where he would end up. It seemed it was enough for him that God knew. Not all of us are called to physically move, although some are at times. What does it look like for you to 'pick up your stuff' and set out? Perhaps it is a heart journey, or a mental upgrade, or perhaps a spiritual one.

Because Abraham obeyed before he had proof of the final outcome, he received everything God promised him. If he had never left Ur, he would never have inherited his promised land.

What has God given you a word about? Have you tested it to be certain it is the word of the Lord? Do you have faith to act on the word even if you don't have all the details worked out? If not, is there something more you need from the Lord in order to properly discern his word and step out in faith? If so, ask! He is faithful! 2Timothy 2:13

I bless you to properly discern the voice of the Lord in both the big things and the small ones, and to step out in faith to receive all He has stored up for you.

FIT TOGETHER INTO GOD'S PERFECT PLAN
